# A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING A CERTAIN RULE OF THE DE PARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME RELATING TO RULES GOVERNING FISH.

### 4 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

5 WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive 6 agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the 7 event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with 8 legislative intent; and

9 WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that a certain rule of the
10 Department of Fish and Game relating to Rules Governing Fish is not consis11 tent with legislative intent and should be rejected.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Second Regular Session of the Sixtieth Idaho Legislature, the Senate and the House of Representatives concurring therein, that IDAPA 13.01.11, Rules Governing Fish, Section 201, Fishing Methods and Gear, Subsection 11, Use of Hands, only, relating to Rules of the Department of Fish and Game, adopted as a pending rule under Docket Number 13-0111-0901, be, and the same is hereby rejected and declared null, void and of no force and effect.
