> to consider inserting verbage that would protect the citizens of this
> state from nuclear waste being stored in Idaho. When nuclear plants
> are considered in the State of Idaho, I urge the Energy, Environment
> and Technology Committee to be involved from the beginning. Working
> with the county that is being looked at for siting, the state needs to
> consider not just that county, but, all surrounding counties since
> more that just the county in question would be affected.
