- RELATING TO THE ALTERATION OF CHANNELS OF STREAMS; AMENDING SECTION 42-3806, 2 IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE THAT IN SPECIFIED SITUATIONS, NO PERMIT SHALL BE 3 REQUIRED BY THE STATE OR ANY AGENCY OR POLITICAL SUBDIVISION THEREOF 4 FROM A WATER USER OR HIS AGENT AND TO PROVIDE THAT SPECIFIED PROVISIONS 5 SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED TO AFFECT THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 10, TITLE 46, 6 IDAHO CODE, OR TO EXEMPT WATER USERS OR THEIR AGENTS FROM COMPLIANCE 7 WITH APPLICABLE LOCAL FLOOD PLAIN ORDINANCES. 8
- 9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Section 42-3806, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 10 amended to read as follows: 11

12 42-3806. EXISTING RIGHTS UNAFFECTED -- WHERE PERMIT NOT RE-QUIRED. This act shall not operate or be so construed as to impair, diminish, 13 control or divest any existing or vested water rights acquired under the 14 laws of the state of Idaho or the United States, nor to interfere with the 15 diversion of water from streams under existing or vested water right or water 16 right permit for irrigation, domestic, commercial or other uses as recog-17 nized and provided for by Idaho water laws. 18

No permit shall be required by the state or any agency or political sub-19 division thereof, from a water user or his agent to clean, maintain, con-20 struct in, or repair any stream channel, diversion structure, canal, ditch, 21 22 drain or lateral. No permit shall be required by the state or any agency or 23 political subdivision thereof, from a water user or his agent to remove any 24 obstruction from any stream channel, if such obstruction interferes with, or is likely to interfere with, the delivery of, or use of, water under any ex-25 26 isting or vested water right, or water right permit.

Nothing in this section shall be construed to affect the provisions of 27 chapter 10, title 46, Idaho Code, or to exempt a water user or his agent from 28 compliance with any applicable local flood plain ordinance adopted pursuant 29 to section 46-1022, Idaho Code. 30
