SENATE AMENDMENT TO H.B. NO. 193, As Amended

AMENDMENT TO SECTION 1

1
2 On page 4 of the engrossed bill, delete lines 33 through 50; and on page 5,
3 delete lines 1 and 2, and insert:

4 "(6) (a) In any action or proceeding brought for the purpose of setting
5 aside a special permit issued pursuant to this section, in which any
6 party seeks a stay or seeks a temporary restraining order or preliminary
7 injunction against the department, other appropriate authority, the
8 state of Idaho or any party requesting the permit, the court may require
9 bond as provided in rule 65(c) of the Idaho rules of civil procedure,
10 in an amount not to exceed ten percent (10%) of the shipper's or trans-
11 porter's insured value of the product or material to be transported
12 under the provisions of the permit. If any attorney's fees and/or costs
13 are awarded to the department or other state actor, such bond may be used
14 to satisfy that award and all awarded amounts shall be paid to the state
15 highway account established in section 40-702, Idaho Code.

16 (b) Where there is a final judgment in an action or proceeding brought
17 for the purpose of setting aside a special permit issued pursuant to
18 this section against the party or parties who brought such action or
19 proceeding, the court may determine the actual damages resulting from
20 the action or proceeding caused to the department or other state actor
21 and may award up to that amount to the party or parties."

22 CORRECTION TO TITLE

23 On page 1, delete lines 3 through 6, and insert: "VIDE THAT IN CERTAIN AC-
24 TIONS OR PROCEEDINGS THE COURT MAY REQUIRE BOND, TO PROVIDE FOR THE SATISFAC-
25 TION OF CERTAIN ATTORNEY'S FEES AND COSTS, TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF ALL
26 AWARDED AMOUNTS TO THE STATE HIGHWAY ACCOUNT, TO PROVIDE THAT WHERE THERE ARE
27 CERTAIN FINAL JUDGMENTS THE COURT MAY DETERMINE THE ACTUAL DAMAGES CAUSED TO
28 THE DEPARTMENT OR OTHER STATE ACTOR AND MAY AWARD UP TO THAT AMOUNT TO THE
29 PARTY OR PARTIES AND TO MAKE A TECHNICAL CORRECTION; AND DECLARING AN EMER-
30 GENCY."
