HOUSE BILL NO. 248

BY APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE

AN ACT

1 APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE FOR FIS-
 2 CAL YEAR 2011; DIRECTING THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM THE RURAL ECONOMIC
 3 DEVELOPMENT INTEGRATED FREIGHT AND TRANSPORTATION FUND TO THE INVASIVE
 4 SPECIES FUND; APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE FOR
 5 FISCAL YEAR 2012; APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICUL-
 6 TURE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2012 FOR THE PLANT INDUSTRIES PROGRAM; LIMITING THE
 7 NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS; AND DECLARING AN
 8 EMERGENCY.
 9

10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

11 SECTION 1. In addition to the appropriation made in Section 3, Chapter
 12 230, Laws of 2010, and any other appropriation provided for by law, there is
 13 hereby appropriated \$1,400,000 from the Federal Grant Fund to the Department
 14 of Agriculture, to be expended for trustee and benefit payments, for the pe-
 15 riod July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2011.

16 SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated and the State Controller shall
 17 transfer \$900,000 from the Rural Economic Development Integrated Freight
 18 and Transportation Revolving Loan Account to the Invasive Species Fund on
 19 July 1, 2011, or as soon thereafter as is practicable.

20 SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Agricul-
 21 ture, the following amounts to be expended according to the designated pro-
 22 grams and expense classes, from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2011,
 23 through June 30, 2012:

34 SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Agriculture
35 for the Plant Industries Program \$2,415,000 from the Invasive Species
36 Fund to be expended for the period July 1, 2011, through June 30, 2012.

1 SECTION 5. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519,
2 Idaho Code, the Department of Agriculture is authorized no more than one hun-
3 dred ninety-four and sixty-eight hundredths (194.68) full-time equivalent
4 positions at any point during the period July 1, 2011, through June 30, 2012,
5 unless specifically authorized by the Governor. The Joint Finance-Appro-
6 priations Committee will be notified promptly of any increased positions so
7 authorized.

8 SECTION 6. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
9 declared to exist, Section 1 of this act shall be in full force and effect on
10 and after passage and approval.
