SENATE AMENDMENT TO S.B. NO. 1001

AMENDMENT TO SECTION 1

1  
2 On page 2 of the printed bill, in line 40, delete ". Unlicensed"; delete  
3 lines 41 through 50; on page 3, delete lines 1 through 4, and insert: ", sub-  
4 ject to the following:

5 (a) Any unlicensed operators under the age of sixteen (16) years, on  
6 national forest roads must have completed a motorbike or ATV safety  
7 course approved by the Idaho department of parks and recreation, and a  
8 certificate or other proof of completion of such safety course shall be  
9 in the possession of the unlicensed operator of any ATV, UTV, specialty  
10 off-highway vehicle or motorbike, or shall be present in the vehicle at  
11 all times when the vehicle is operated on national forest roads. The  
12 certificate or proof of completion shall be provided for inspection to  
13 any peace officer upon request. No person shall be convicted of violat-  
14 ing the provisions of this subsection if that person produces, at any  
15 time prior to conviction, the certificate or proof of completion of the  
16 approved safety course where the certificate shows completion of the  
17 course prior to the violation. In the event of a violation of the provi-  
18 sions of this subsection, the supervising adult may be charged with an  
19 infraction.

20 (b) For purposes of this subsection, "supervised" means that the su-  
21 pervising adult must be in a position, on another ATV, UTV, specialty  
22 off-highway vehicle or motorbike, or if on the ground, within three hun-  
23 dred (300) feet of the unlicensed operator, to provide close support,  
24 assistance or direction to the unlicensed operator."

25 CORRECTION TO TITLE

26 On page 1, in line 4, delete "UNLICENSED"; delete lines 6 through 18,  
27 and insert: "WAY VEHICLES OR MOTORBIKES ON CERTAIN ROADS, TO PROVIDE THAT  
28 CERTAIN UNLICENSED OPERATORS ON NATIONAL FOREST ROADS MUST HAVE COMPLETED A  
29 SAFETY COURSE, TO PROVIDE THAT A CERTIFICATE OR PROOF OF COMPLETION SHALL BE  
30 IN THE POSSESSION OF THE UNLICENSED OPERATOR OR PRESENT IN THE VEHICLE, TO  
31 PROVIDE THAT THE CERTIFICATE OR PROOF OF COMPLETION SHALL BE PROVIDED FOR IN-  
32 SPECTION, TO PROVIDE THAT NO PERSON SHALL BE CONVICTED OF A CERTAIN VIOLA-  
33 TION IF THAT PERSON PRODUCES, PRIOR TO CONVICTION, THE CERTIFICATE OR PROOF  
34 OF COMPLETION THAT SHOWS COMPLETION OF THE COURSE PRIOR TO THE VIOLATION, TO  
35 PROVIDE FOR AN INFRACTION, AND TO DEFINE A TERM."
