SENATE BILL NO. 1071

AN ACT

1 RELATING TO THE POW/MIA FLAG; AMENDING CHAPTER 23, TITLE 67, IDAHO CODE, BY
2 THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 67-2303, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE FOR THE
3 DISPLAY OF THE POW/MIA FLAG.

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 SECTION 1. That Chapter 23, Title 67, Idaho Code, be, and the same is
7 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a NEW SECTION, to be known and des-
8 ignated as Section 67-2303, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

9 67-2303. DISPLAY OF POW/MIA FLAG. (1) The POW/MIA flag may be dis-
10 played on or in front of the locations prescribed in subsection (2) of this
11 section on any day when the United States flag is displayed.

12 (2) The locations for the display of the POW/MIA flag pursuant to sub-
13 section (1) of this section are the following:

14 (a) The state capitol building;

15 (b) The building that serves as the location of a district court in a
16 county;

17 (c) The building that serves as the city or town hall of each incorpo-
18 rated city or town; and

19 (d) The building that serves as the main administrative building of
20 each county.

21 (3) Protocol for flying POW/MIA flags shall be as follows: If flying
22 the flag from one (1) flag pole, the POW/MIA flag is flown directly below the
23 National Colors and above any state flag. If flying National, POW/MIA and
24 State flags from two (2) poles, the POW/MIA flag should be flown from the
25 same pole as the National Colors, and beneath the American Flag, with the
26 state flag flying from the pole to the left. If flying flags from three (3)
27 poles, the National Colors occupy the place of prominence, the right, with
28 the POW/MIA flag immediately to the left of the U.S. Flag, and the state flag
29 to the left of the POW/MIA flag.
