SENATE BILL NO. 1100

BY HEALTH AND WELFARE COMMITTEE

AN ACT

1 RELATING TO IMMUNIZATIONS; AMENDING SECTION 39-4801, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE
2 A DOCUMENT NAME, TO PROVIDE FOR THE SIGNING OF AN IMMUNIZATION RECORD BY
3 ANOTHER HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONAL, TO PROVIDE THAT THE SIGNATURE ON AN
4 IMMUNIZATION RECORD SHALL VERIFY CERTAIN INFORMATION AND TO MAKE TECH-
5 NICAL CORRECTIONS.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

8 SECTION 1. That Section 39-4801, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
9 amended to read as follows:

10 39-4801. IMMUNIZATION REQUIRED. Except as provided in section
11 39-4802, Idaho Code, any child in Idaho of school age may attend grades
12 preschool and kindergarten through twelve (12) of any public, private or
13 parochial school operating in this state if otherwise eligible, provided
14 that upon admission, the parent or guardian shall provide ~~a statement~~ an im-
15 munization record to the school authorities regarding the child's immunity
16 to certain childhood diseases. This ~~statement shall provide a certificate~~
17 record, signed by a physician or his representative or another licensed
18 health care professional, shall verify that such child has received, or is
19 in the process of receiving immunizations as specified by the state board of
20 health and welfare, or can effectively demonstrate, through verification
21 in a form approved by the department of health and welfare, immunity gained
22 through prior contraction of the disease.

23 Immunizations required and the manner and frequency of their adminis-
24 tration shall be as prescribed by the state board of health and welfare and
25 shall conform to recognized standard medical practices in the state. The
26 state board of health and welfare, in cooperation with the state board of ed-
27 ucation and the Idaho school boards association, shall promulgate appropri-
28 ate rules ~~and regulations~~ for the enforcement of the required immunization
29 program and specify reporting requirements of schools, pursuant to the pro-
30 visions of chapter 52, title 67, Idaho Code.
