SENATE BILL NO. 1101

BY HEALTH AND WELFARE COMMITTEE

2 RELATING TO DAYCARE FACILITIES; AMENDING SECTION 39-1118, IDAHO CODE, TO
3 REVISE A DOCUMENT NAME, TO PROVIDE FOR THE SIGNING OF AN IMMUNIZATION
4 RECORD, TO PROVIDE THAT THE SIGNATURE ON AN IMMUNIZATION RECORD SHALL
5 VERIFY CERTAIN INFORMATION AND TO MAKE A TECHNICAL CORRECTION.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

7 SECTION 1. That Section 39-1118, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
8 amended to read as follows:

9 39-1118. IMMUNIZATION REQUIRED. (1) Within fourteen (14) days of a
10 child's initial attendance at any licensed daycare facility, the parent or
11 guardian shall provide ~~a statement~~ an immunization record to the operator
12 of the daycare facility regarding the child's immunity to certain childhood
13 diseases. This ~~statement shall provide a certificate record,~~ signed by a
14 physician or ~~a his representative of a district health department or another~~
15 licensed health care professional, shall verify that the child has received,
16 or is in the process of receiving immunizations as specified by the board; or
17 can effectively demonstrate, through verification in a form approved by the
18 department, immunity gained through prior contraction of the disease.

19 Immunizations required and the manner and frequency of their adminis-
20 tration shall be as prescribed by the board and shall conform to recognized
21 standard medical practices in the state. The board shall promulgate appro-
22 priate rules for the enforcement of the required immunization program and
23 specify reporting requirements of daycare facilities, pursuant to the pro-
24 visions of chapter 52, title 67, Idaho Code.

25 (2) Any minor child whose parent or guardian has submitted to officials
26 of a licensed daycare facility a certificate signed by a physician licensed
27 by the state board of medicine stating that the physical condition of the
28 child is such that all or any of the required immunizations would endanger
29 the life or health of the child shall be exempt from the provisions of this
30 section. Any minor child whose parent or guardian has submitted a signed
31 statement to officials of the daycare facility stating their objections on
32 religious or other grounds shall be exempt from the provisions of this sec-
33 tion.
