SENATE BILL NO. 1133

BY STATE AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

AN ACT

1 RELATING TO HORSE RACING; AMENDING SECTION 54-2508, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE  
2 PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE NUMBER OF RACES PER DAY AND THE NUMBER OF DAYS  
3 OF RACING.

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 SECTION 1. That Section 54-2508, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby  
7 amended to read as follows:

8 54-2508. LICENSE -- APPLICATION THEREFOR -- TYPE AND NUMBER OF RACES  
9 -- FEE PER DAY -- REFUND -- CANCELLATION -- HEARING -- SIMULCAST PURSE MONEYS  
10 FUND. It shall be unlawful for any person to hold any race meet in this state  
11 without having first obtained and having in force and effect a license issued  
12 by the commission as in this chapter provided. Every person making appli-  
13 cation for a license to hold a race meet, under the provisions of this chap-  
14 ter, shall file an application with the commission which shall set forth the  
15 time, place and number of days such will continue, an agreement with a horse-  
16 men's group as the term "horsemen's group" is defined in section 54-2502,  
17 Idaho Code, and such other information as the commission may require. The  
18 agreement shall be reached voluntarily or pursuant to binding arbitration  
19 in conformance with chapter 9, title 7, Idaho Code, and shall address, but  
20 not be limited to, number of live race days and percentage of the live race  
21 and simulcast handle that is dedicated to the live horse race purse struc-  
22 ture. In addition, the agreement shall provide that all simulcast purse mon-  
23 eys that are accrued as required by the horsemen's agreement be held in the  
24 simulcast purse moneys fund created pursuant to the provisions of this sec-  
25 tion. Race days agreed upon shall be submitted to the Idaho racing commis-  
26 sion for its approval.

27 No person who has been convicted of any crime involving moral turpitude  
28 shall be issued a license of any kind, nor shall any license be issued to any  
29 person who has violated the terms or provisions of this chapter, or any of the  
30 rules of the commission, or who has failed to pay any of the fees, taxes or  
31 moneys required under the provisions of this chapter.

32 All applications to hold race meets shall be submitted to the commission  
33 which shall act upon such applications within thirty (30) days. The commis-  
34 sion shall be the sole judge of whether or not the race meet shall be licensed  
35 and the number of days the meet shall continue.

36 The license issued shall specify the kind and character of the race  
37 meets to be held, the number of days the race meet shall continue and the num-  
38 ber of races per day. For those licensees or facilities that have had a total  
39 race handle from both live races and simulcast races exceeding five million  
40 dollars (\$5,000,000) during the last calendar year in operation, the number  
41 of races per day shall not be less than eight (8) and the number of days of  
42 racing shall not be less than forty-six (46) unless otherwise agreed by the

1 licensee and the horsemen's group. For those licensees or facilities that  
2 have had a total race handle from both live races and simulcast races of five  
3 million dollars (\$5,000,000) or less during the last calendar year in opera-  
4 tion, the number of races per day shall not be less than six (6) and the number  
5 of days of racing shall not be less than two (2). The licensee shall pay in  
6 advance of the scheduled race meet to the state treasurer a fee of not less  
7 than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for each day of racing, which fees shall  
8 be placed in the public school income fund of the state of Idaho. Provided,  
9 that if unforeseen obstacles arise, which prevent the holding, or completion  
10 of any race meet, the license fee held may be refunded the licensee, if the  
11 commission deems the reason for failure to hold or complete the race meet  
12 sufficient. Any unexpired license held by any person who violates any of  
13 the provisions of this chapter, pursuant thereto, or who fails to pay to the  
14 commission any and all sums required under the provisions of this chapter,  
15 shall be subject to cancellation and revocation by the commission. Such  
16 cancellation shall be made only after a summary hearing before the commis-  
17 sion, of which three (3) days' notice in writing shall be given the licensee,  
18 specifying the grounds for the proposed cancellation, and at which hearing  
19 the licensee shall be given an opportunity to be heard in opposition to the  
20 proposed cancellation.

21 The simulcast purse moneys fund is hereby created in the state treasury.  
22 Moneys in the fund shall consist of all simulcast purse moneys that are ac-  
23 crued as required by horsemen's agreements. Moneys in the fund are hereby  
24 perpetually appropriated to the Idaho state racing commission for distri-  
25 bution pursuant to the provisions of horsemen's agreements and rules of the  
26 commission. The commission is authorized to promulgate rules providing for  
27 the receipt, deposit, withdrawal and distribution of such moneys. The state  
28 treasurer shall invest idle moneys in the fund and any interest received on  
29 those investments shall be returned to the fund.
