AN ACT

1 RELATING TO EMPLOYMENT; AMENDING SECTION 44-1301, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE PRO-
2 VISIONS RELATING TO RESTRICTIONS ON EMPLOYMENT OF CERTAIN CHILDREN.

4 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

5 SECTION 1. That Section 44-1301, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
6 amended to read as follows:

7 44-1301. RESTRICTIONS ON EMPLOYMENT OF CHILDREN UNDER FOURTEEN. No
8 child under fourteen (14) years of age shall be employed, permitted or suf-
9 fered to work in or in connection with any mine, factory, workshop, mercan-
10 tile establishment, store, telegraph or telephone office, laundry, restau-
11 rant, hotel, apartment house, or in the distribution or transmission of
12 merchandise or messages. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corpo-
13 ration to employ any child under fourteen (14) years of age in any business or
14 service whatever during the hours in which the public schools of the district
15 in which the child resides are in session, or before the hour of six o'clock
16 in the morning, or after the hour of nine o'clock in the evening: provided,
17 that any child over the age of twelve (12) years may be employed at any of the
18 occupations mentioned in this chapter during the regular vacations of two
19 (2) weeks or more of the public schools of the district in which such child
20 resides. Provided however, a student may be employed by the public schools
21 of the district for a maximum of ten (10) hours per week provided such employ-
22 ment is voluntary and with the consent of the student's legal guardian.
