SENATE BILL NO. 1183

AN ACT

1 APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION FOR THE  
2 SCHOLARSHIPS AND GRANTS PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2011; APPROPRIATING  
3 MONEYS TO THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION FOR SPECIAL PROGRAMS FOR FISCAL  
4 YEAR 2012; LIMITING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSI-  
5 TIONS; PROVIDING LEGISLATIVE INTENT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

8 SECTION 1. In addition to the appropriation made in Section 3, Chapter  
9 199, Laws of 2010, and any other appropriation provided for by law, there is  
10 hereby appropriated \$30,000 from the General Fund to the Board of Regents of  
11 the University of Idaho and the State Board of Education for the Scholarships  
12 and Grants Program, to be expended for trustee and benefit payments, for the  
13 period July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2011.

14 SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Board of Regents of the  
15 University of Idaho and the State Board of Education the following amounts  
16 to be expended according to the designated programs from the listed funds for  
17 the period July 1, 2011, through June 30, 2012:

8 SECTION 3. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519,  
9 Idaho Code, each of the programs in the Board of Regents of the University  
10 of Idaho and the State Board of Education listed below is authorized no more  
11 than the number of full-time equivalent positions shown at any point during  
12 the period July 1, 2011, through June 30, 2012, unless specifically autho-  
13 rized by the Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be  
14 notified promptly of any increased positions so authorized.

21 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the Legislature that  
22 the moneys appropriated for the Idaho Robert R. Lee Promise B Scholarship in  
23 Section 2 of this act for Scholarships and Grants shall be used as a match  
24 by Idaho for students who have participated in Gaining Early Awareness and  
25 Readiness for Undergraduate Programs (GEAR UP) and who also meet the eli-  
26 gibility requirements of the Promise B Scholarship; provided however, that  
27 students who did not participate in GEAR UP, but meet the eligibility re-  
28 quirements of the Promise B Scholarship, shall also receive the scholarship.

29 SECTION 5. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby  
30 declared to exist, Section 1 of this act shall be in full force and effect on  
31 and after passage and approval.
