SENATE BILL NO. 1203

AN ACT

1 APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE DIVISION OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2012;
2 AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE ALLOCATION OF FUNDS FOR THE VARIOUS
3 PROJECTS SPECIFIED; PROVIDING LEGISLATIVE INTENT RELATING TO UTI-
4 LIZATION OF MATCHING FUNDS; EXEMPTING THE APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE
5 PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 36, TITLE 67, IDAHO CODE, AND FROM THE PROVISIONS
6 OF SECTION 67-3516, IDAHO CODE; AUTHORIZING THE USE OF TAX ANTICIPATION
7 NOTES; AND PROVIDING LEGISLATIVE INTENT RELATING TO THE REALLOCATION OF
8 PROJECT SAVINGS.

10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

11 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Division of Public Works
12 \$21,245,400 from the Permanent Building Fund, to be expended for capital
13 outlay, for the period July 1, 2011, through June 30, 2012.

14 SECTION 2. ALLOCATION OF FUNDS FOR SPECIFIED PROJECTS. Moneys appro-
15 priated in Section 1 of this act, or so much thereof as in each case may be
16 necessary, shall be used for the purpose of paying the cost of any land,
17 building, equipment, or the rebuilding, renovation or repair of buildings,
18 installations, facilities or structures at the places, institutions and
19 agencies, or their successors, including those listed in this section. The
20 Permanent Building Fund Advisory Council is hereby authorized and directed
21 to anticipate revenues accruing to the Permanent Building Fund for the pur-
22 pose of undertaking the construction, renovation, repair and acquisitions
23 herein authorized, without delay, and to determine the priority of construc-
24 tion pursuant to which the work hereunder will be undertaken.

8 SECTION 3. UTILIZATION OF MATCHING FUNDS. It is legislative intent that
9 the moneys appropriated in this act may be made available for matching any
10 allocation of moneys now in existence or hereafter made available by agen-
11 cies of the United States and/or private donations; and it is further the ex-
12 press intention of the Legislature to authorize the Division of Public Works
13 to expend, for the purpose of paying the cost of any land, building, equip-
14 ment or the rebuilding, renovation or repair of buildings, moneys appropri-
15 ated for public works to various agencies as part of the respective agency
16 operating budgets; provided the express approval by the Permanent Building
17 Fund Advisory Council is granted to make application for such moneys in each
18 instance.

19 SECTION 4. EXEMPTION OF APPROPRIATIONS FROM CERTAIN PROVISIONS. All
20 appropriations made herein shall be exempt from the provisions of Chapter
21 36, Title 67 and Section 67-3516, Idaho Code, but shall be available for
22 expenditure only after allotment in accordance with the other provisions
23 of Chapter 35, Title 67, Idaho Code, and all appropriations made hereunder
24 shall be subject to the provisions of Section 67-5711, Idaho Code, except as
25 otherwise provided herein.

26 SECTION 5. ISSUANCE OF TAX ANTICIPATION NOTES. The State Treasurer is
27 hereby authorized and directed to anticipate the revenues in the Permanent
28 Building Fund by the issuance of tax anticipation notes in accordance with
29 authority conferred in Sections 63-3201 through 63-3204, Idaho Code, and in
30 accordance with the procedures and subject to the limitations provided in
31 those sections, in the same manner as though the revenues in the General Fund
32 were being anticipated.

33 SECTION 6. REALLOCATION OF PROJECT SAVINGS. It is the intent of the Leg-
34 islature that the Division of Public Works has the flexibility to allocate
35 any savings or unused appropriation from any capital, line-item project to
36 any other requested and funded fiscal year 2012 capital project. The re-
37 allocation of such appropriation must be approved by the Permanent Building
38 Fund Advisory Council prior to the funds being spent.
