SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 101

A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO SECTION 8, ARTICLE III, OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE
2 STATE OF IDAHO, RELATING TO SESSIONS OF THE LEGISLATURE; TO PROVIDE THAT
3 SESSIONS OF THE LEGISLATURE SHALL NOT EXCEED EIGHTY CALENDAR DAYS IN DU-
4 RATION; STATING THE QUESTION TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE ELECTORATE; DIRECT-
5 ING THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL TO PREPARE THE STATEMENTS REQUIRED BY LAW;
6 AND DIRECTING THE SECRETARY OF STATE TO PUBLISH THE AMENDMENT AND ARGU-
7 MENTS AS REQUIRED BY LAW.

9 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

10 SECTION 1. That Section 8, Article III, of the Constitution of the
11 State of Idaho be amended to read as follows:

12 SECTION 8. SESSIONS OF LEGISLATURE. The sessions of the leg-
13 islature shall be held annually at the capital of the state, com-
14 mencing on the second Monday of January of each year, unless a dif-
15 ferent day shall have been appointed by law, and at other times when
16 convened by the governor. Sessions of the legislature shall not ex-
17 ceed eighty calendar days in duration.

18 SECTION 2. The question to be submitted to the electors of the State of
19 Idaho at the next general election shall be as follows:

20 "Shall Section 8, Article III, of the Constitution of the State of Idaho
21 be amended to provide that sessions of the Legislature shall not exceed
22 eighty calendar days in duration?".

23 SECTION 3. The Legislative Council is directed to prepare the state-
24 ments required by Section 67-453, Idaho Code, and file the same.

25 SECTION 4. The Secretary of State is hereby directed to publish this
26 proposed constitutional amendment and arguments as required by law.
