





Plates were in the water for 6 weeks










U.S. Zebra/Quagga Expansion 2006-2012








The “Double Bogey” Commercially Hauled (Lake Mead to Lake Coeur d’Alene)





Idaho mussel-fouled boat interceptions 2009-2012*









