2 RELATING TO FISH AND GAME; AMENDING SECTION 36-405, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE
3 FOR THE DESIGNATION OF CONTROLLED HUNT TAGS AND CONTROLLED HUNT PERMITS
4 TO CERTAIN MINOR CHILDREN OR GRANDCHILDREN BY PARENTS AND GRANDPARENTS
5 AND TO PROVIDE THAT SUCH DESIGNATED TAGS AND PERMITS CANNOT BE SOLD.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

7 SECTION 1. That Section 36-405, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
8 amended to read as follows:

9 36-405. APPLICATION FOR LICENSE -- DUPLICATE LICENSE -- UNLAWFUL PUR-
10 CHASE, POSSESSION, AND USE OF LICENSE. (a) Application Required.

11 1. Any person making application for a senior resident license, or res-
12 ident license shall provide his Idaho driver's license number as proof
13 of residence, or in the case of nondrivers, other suitable proof of res-
14 idency, and state the class of license applied for, the name of the ap-
15 plicant, the age of the applicant, his date of birth, his length of res-
16 idence, his current address, and such other information as may be re-
17 quired by the director.

18 2. Any person making application for a duplicate license shall state
19 the type and class of license originally purchased and such other infor-
20 mation as may be required by the director.

21 3. No person shall willfully make a false statement as to:

22 (A) Name, age, his date of birth, length of residence or current
23 address when such statement is made for the purpose of obtaining
24 any license.

25 (B) Type and class of original license purchased when applying for
26 a duplicate license.

27 (b) Loss of License -- New One Required. In case of loss of a license,
28 a new one shall be required to entitle the person who lost the same to hunt,
29 fish or trap. Such person may upon application:

30 1. Purchase a new license at the regular fee; or

31 2. Replace a lost license with a duplicate license for which a fee as
32 specified in section 36-416, Idaho Code, shall be charged.

33 3. When a duplicate license has been issued the original license shall
34 become null and void.

35 (c) Unlawful Purchase, Possession and Use of License.

36 1. Every person buying a license must buy a license of the proper type
37 or class according to his residence and age. No person shall purchase or
38 possess a license of the wrong class and such license shall be void and
39 of no effect from the date of issuance.

40 2. No person shall:

41 (A) Acquire more than one (1) regular controlled hunt permit per
42 species or more tags per species than the commission has set a bag

1 limit for that species except as provided in subsection (b) of this
2 section or to have said permits or tags in his possession.

3 (B) Transfer any fishing, hunting, or trapping license to any
4 other person or for any person to make use of such license issued to
5 any other person with the exception of a parent or grandparent des-
6 ignating any controlled hunt tag or controlled hunt permit to a mi-
7 nor child or grandchild as prescribed by rules of the commission.
8 A controlled hunt tag or controlled hunt permit can be designated
9 only to a minor child with a valid hunting license or one who is
10 participating in a mentored hunting program as prescribed by rules
11 of the commission. A controlled hunt tag or controlled hunt permit
12 designated to a minor child cannot be sold.
