HOUSE BILL NO. 532

BY JUDICIARY, RULES, AND ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE

AN ACT

1 RELATING TO THE PEACE OFFICER STANDARDS AND TRAINING COUNCIL; AMENDING CHAP-
2 TER 51, TITLE 19, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 19-5118,
3 IDAHO CODE, TO GRANT THE PEACE OFFICER STANDARDS AND TRAINING COUNCIL
4 THE AUTHORITY TO ESTABLISH AND ASSESS CERTAIN FEES, TO REQUIRE THE COUN-
5 CIL TO DEPOSIT SUCH FEES INTO A CERTAIN FUND AND TO GRANT THE COUNCIL THE
6 AUTHORITY TO EXPEND MONEYS TO COVER THE COSTS FOR CERTAIN USES.

8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

9 SECTION 1. That Chapter 51, Title 19, Idaho Code, be, and the same is
10 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a NEW SECTION, to be known and des-
11 ignated as Section 19-5118, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

12 19-5118. POWER OF THE COUNCIL TO ESTABLISH AND ASSESS FEES. (1) The
13 council may establish and assess fees for:

14 (a) The use of its facilities and equipment by private entities and non-
15 law enforcement institutions;

16 (b) The use of its facilities and equipment by law enforcement agencies
17 for purposes other than basic training; and

18 (c) Facilitating, arranging, providing or assisting with the train-
19 ing, certification or continuing education requirements of private en-
20 tities, non-law enforcement institutions and law enforcement agencies.

21 (2) The council shall deposit assessed fees into the peace officer
22 standards and training fund established in section 19-5116, Idaho Code. The
23 council may expend moneys as deemed necessary to cover the costs for the uses
24 identified in this section.
