

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS20827C2

This proposal adds Idaho Code section 19-5118 to allow the Peace Officer Standards and Training Council legal authority to collect fees for dormitory use, use of training equipment for non-POST training, use of POST training facilities by non-POST users, ability to collect fees for administrative requirements leading to POST required training or certification. The Council is requesting the authority to collect reasonable fees for use of facilities and equipment, and administrative work for vocational peace officer training programs and private corporations requiring peace officer training and certification.

FISCAL NOTE

Allowing the POST Council to continue to collect dormitory and advanced training fees in the amount of approximately \$112,000 per fiscal year will off-set existing costs incurred by POST.

Allowing the POST Council to collect fees from non-law enforcement agencies and private entities for the use of the training track, classrooms, and training equipment will generate approximately \$20,000 per fiscal year, will off-set costs incurred by POST, and will provide a legal remedy for the external use of POST resources and manpower.
