1 RELATING TO PORT DISTRICTS; AMENDING SECTION 70-1101, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE
2 PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE AUTHORIZATION OF PORT DISTRICTS AND TO MAKE
3 TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS; AND AMENDING SECTION 70-1107, IDAHO CODE, TO RE-
4 VISE PROVISIONS RELATING TO AN ELECTION AND TO MAKE A TECHNICAL CORREC-
5 TION.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

8 SECTION 1. That Section 70-1101, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
9 amended to read as follows:

10 70-1101. PORT DISTRICTS AUTHORIZED -- OBJECTS AND PURPOSES. Port
11 districts are hereby authorized for the acquirement, construction, main-
12 tenance, operation, development and regulation of harbor, commercial,
13 manufacturing or industrial improvements, land ~~and~~ or water transfer and
14 terminal facilities, industrial and economic development, and other de-
15 velopment, facilities, and services, reasonably incident to a modern,
16 efficient and competitive port, and may be established under this act in any
17 county bordering ~~upon any continuous waterway system, limited to the port~~
18 ~~area, which will float commercial tug and barge vehicles to ports~~ a national
19 or international trade corridor accessed by means of aviation, rail, motor
20 carrier or barges to other port districts or related facilities handling
21 transoceanic or transcontinental traffic, as in this act provided.

22 SECTION 2. That Section 70-1107, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
23 amended to read as follows:

24 70-1107. ELECTION -- FORM OF BALLOT. In submitting the said question
25 to the voters for their approval or rejection, the proposition shall be ex-
26 pressed on said ballot substantially in the following terms:

27 "Port of Yes."

28 "Port of No."

29 (Giving the name of the principal ~~river~~ port city within such proposed port
30 district; or, if there be more than one (1) city of the same class within such
31 district, such name as may be determined by the board of county commission-
32 ers.)
