HOUSE BILL NO. 683

BY APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE

AN ACT

RELATING TO APPROPRIATIONS TO THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION AND THE BOARD OF REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF IDAHO FOR HEALTH EDUCATION PROGRAMS; AMENDING SECTION 1, CHAPTER 249, LAWS OF 2011, TO MOVE MONEYS FROM OPERATING EXPENDITURES TO PERSONNEL COSTS; APPROPRIATING MONEYS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2013; LIMITING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS; PROVIDING GUIDANCE FOR EMPLOYEE COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS; AND PROVIDING NON-GENERAL FUND REAPPROPRIATION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2013.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Section 1, Chapter 249, Laws of 2011, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Board of Regents of the University of Idaho and the State Board of Education for the Health Education Programs, the following amounts to be expended according to the designated programs and expense classes, from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2011, through June 30, 2012:

15 SECTION 3. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519,
16 Idaho Code, the State Board of Education and the Board of Regents of the
17 University of Idaho for college and universities is authorized no more than
18 twenty and five-tenths (20.5) full-time equivalent positions at any point
19 during the period July 1, 2012, through June 30, 2013, unless specifically
20 authorized by the Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee
21 will be notified promptly of any increased positions so authorized.

22 SECTION 4. EMPLOYEE COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS. The Legislature rec-
23 ognizes and thanks all state workers for their dedication, professionalism
24 and for the personal sacrifices they make every day in the performance of
25 their duties to serve our citizens. In accordance with the provisions of
26 Section 67-5309C, Idaho Code, the Legislature supports the Governor's rec-
27 ommendation in not making changes in annual salaries and benefits for state
28 employees based upon labor markets or specific occupational inequities;
29 directs agencies and institutions that have excess personnel cost appro-
30 priations or salary savings due to turnover to use such funding for a merit
31 increase component, notwithstanding the provisions of Section 67-5309B(4),
32 Idaho Code, to recognize and reward permanent and temporary state employ-
33 ees; and does provide funding to agencies and institutions to provide a two
34 percent (2%) pay increase for all classified and nonclassified permanent
35 performing employees. Performing employees shall be all permanent employ-
36 ees, including adjunct faculty at colleges and universities, who have been
37 rated as "achieves" or better on a performance plan if required by Division
38 of Human Resources rule, including probationary permanent employees making
39 satisfactory progress. The Legislature supports the Governor's recommenda-
40 tion to fund increases in the cost of health insurance benefits and directs
41 the director of the Department of Administration, as the administrator of

1 the state insurance plan, to maintain the current benefit package to the ex-
2 tent possible, which may require a cost sharing on the part of employees for
3 the increased cost of the health insurance plan.

4 SECTION 5. NON-GENERAL FUND REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY. There is hereby
5 reappropriated to the State Board of Education and the Board of Regents of
6 the University of Idaho for the Health Education Programs any unexpended and
7 unencumbered balances of moneys categorized as dedicated funds and federal
8 funds as appropriated for fiscal year 2012, to be used for nonrecurring ex-
9 penditures, for the period July 1, 2012, through June 30, 2013.
