A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING A CERTAIN RULE OF THE BUREAU OF OCCUPATIONAL LICENSES RELATING TO RULES OF THE BOARD OF DRINKING WATER AND WASTEWATER PROFESSIONALS.

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with legislative intent; and

WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that a certain rule of the Bureau of Occupational Licenses relating to Rules of the Board of Drinking Water and Wastewater Professionals is not consistent with legislative intent and should be rejected.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Second Regular Session of the Sixty-first Idaho Legislature, the House of Representatives and the Senate concurring therein, that IDAPA 24.05.01, Bureau of Occupational Licenses, Rules of the Board of Drinking Water and Wastewater Professionals, Section 375, Substitutions, Subsection 02, Substituting Experience for Education, Paragraph c, At least 50% of education is mandatory and cannot be substituted by experience, only, adopted as a pending rule under Docket Number 24-0501-1101, be, and the same is hereby rejected and declared null, void and of no force and effect.
