S1271 LANDS DEPT. GRAZING LEASES	This proposed legislation will amend Idaho Code 58-3 by adding a new section, Idaho Code 58-302, that requires applicants for state grazing leases to submit a grazing management proposal as part of their application. The proposal allows the Department to conduct a preliminary analysis of whether or not an applicant's proposed use is consistent with the Department's resource objectives and management expectations for the lands applied for. The grazing proposal when approved by the Department then becomes the grazing management plan for that lease.	Senator Bert Brackett
S1282 SPECIAL INCENTIVE HUNTING TAGS	This legislation would provide sportsmen access to private land in exchange for the ability of landowners to sell special landowner tags. The legislation would change public policy, which the Fish and Game Commission would establish by rule, a program to provide special tags to hunt antelope, elk or deer in designated units. To be awarded a tag, the private landowner would allow hunters reasonable access.	Senator Bert Brackett
