RS 21266 RE: Revise provisions to certain adjustments to a district's salary-based apportionment

Senator Cameron introduced **RS 21266** which would remove future (FY 2013 and beyond) reductions in salary-based apportionment for school district teachers, administrators, and classified support staff that are required in statute. Reductions were included in S1184 of the 2011 Session and are intended to generate General Fund savings to pay for much of the *Students Come First* education reforms.

RS 21375 **Stan Boyd**, Idaho Cattle Association, introduced RS 21375 which would allow the Idaho Cattle Foundation, Inc. to recommend how funds collected from the sale of stray livestock may be used for public education and higher education programs that advance the livestock industry and agriculture in general. Currently, stray livestock are held by the sheriff for ten days and then sold at auction; funds are ultimately transferred to the Endowment Fund. This bill would allow the funds to be transferred to the State Board of Education and placed in a miscellaneous revenue fund. The Idaho Cattle Foundation could then recommend various ways to spend the money. The average amount collected over the last five years was \$33,800 – the range has been from \$18,000 to \$67,000.
