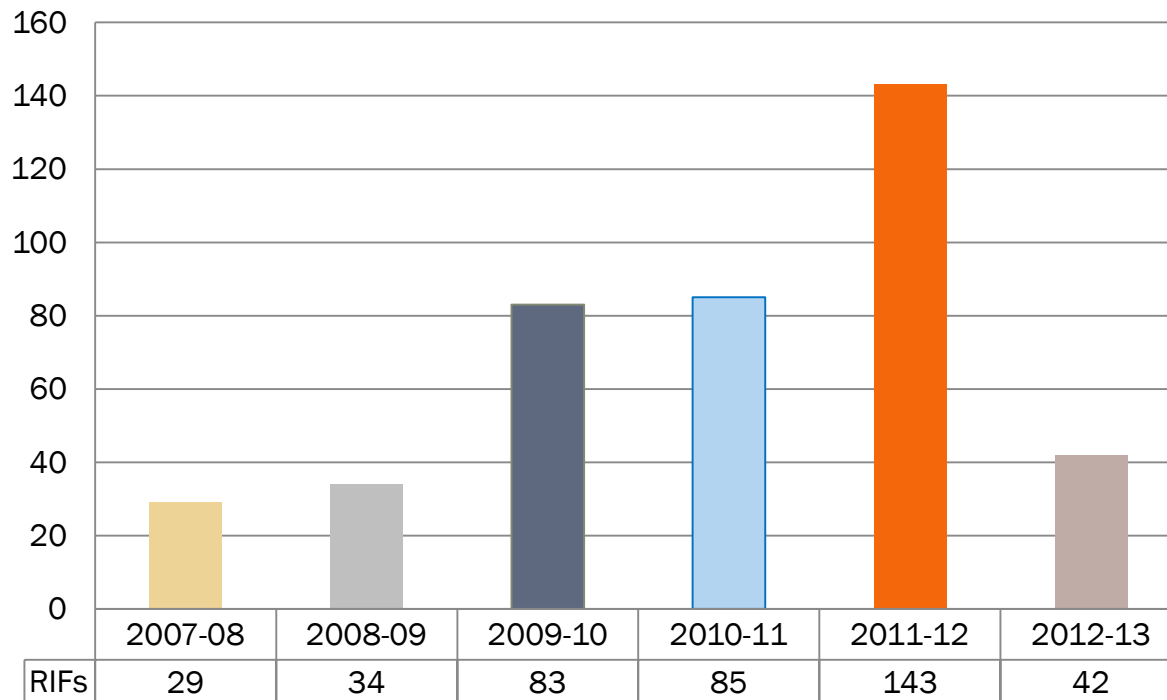

# House Bill 261

## ☞ Position:

- IEA supported this bill.

## ☞ Data:

- Glenn's Ferry- 2 positions
- Bonneville- 5 positions
- East Bonneville- 6 positions
- Clark County- 1 position

## ☞ Recommendations:

- Trust elected school board members to carry out their duties in a responsible manner.
- Remove any portion of the law that limits local control.

# Senate Bill 1040a

## ☞ Position:

- IEA opposed this bill.

## ☞ Data:

- Pocatello
- Mackay

## ☞ Recommendations:

- Allow the law to sunset on July 1, 2014.
- In the meantime, bring the appropriate individuals and groups back to the table to identify workable solutions, with the expectation that a new piece of legislation will be jointly agreed to, drafted and presented to the 2014 Idaho Legislature.

# Senate Bill 1147a

## Recommendations:

- Require that districts choosing to hire outside attorneys or negotiators be completely transparent in reporting to the public any and all costs associated with this contract.
- Revise the language that bargaining commence upon the written request of either party.
- Revisit the June 30 deadline.
