

Purpose of ISAC

Since 1972, Bureau of Justice Statistics has provided funding to states to:

1. Collect, analyze and publish criminal justice data;
2. Analyze data in support of public policy, especially on the themes identified within the annual BJS grant solicitation;
3. Establish and maintain contacts with state criminal justice agencies, the courts, victims organizations, and local governments and their criminal justice agencies;
4. Assist criminal justice agencies with defining their needs for specific statistical and other information needed to plan, implement and evaluate criminal justice programs; and
5. Provide technical assistance to collect, interpret, use and share statistical information.

** Funding for this purpose has stayed around \$50,000 per state for the past 40 years. Used to partially fund 2 full-time and one part-time position.*

Purpose of ISAC

- *Idaho SAC has been housed within ISP (formerly Idaho Dept. of Law Enforcement since 1978.*
- Have provided assistance to STOP and Byrne/JAG management team since mid-1990s.
- Conduct impact evaluations and provide technical support to Idaho STOP and Byrne sub-grantees
- Provide assistance to other state agencies as necessary through membership on various committees
