HOUSE BILL NO. 154

BY JUDICIARY, RULES, AND ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE

AN ACT

1 RELATING TO JUDGMENT; AMENDING CHAPTER 25, TITLE 19, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDI-
2 TION OF A NEW SECTION 19-2520H, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE FOR THE EXTENSION
3 OF A SENTENCE FOR CERTAIN VIOLATIONS AGAINST OLDER PERSONS.

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 SECTION 1. That Chapter 25, Title 19, Idaho Code, be, and the same is
7 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a NEW SECTION, to be known and des-
8 ignated as Section 19-2520H, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

9 19-2520H. EXTENSION OF SENTENCE FOR VIOLATIONS AGAINST OLDER PER-
10 SONS. (1) Any person who is found guilty of or pleads guilty to a violation of
11 section 18-905 (aggravated assault), 18-907 (aggravated battery), 18-910
12 (assault with intent to commit a serious felony), 18-911 (battery with the
13 intent to commit a serious felony), 18-2403 (theft), 18-3002 (receiving
14 money or property under false personation), 18-3126 (misappropriation of
15 personal identifying information), 18-3601 (forgery), chapter 40, title
16 18 (homicide), section 18-4501 (kidnaping defined), 18-4502 (first degree
17 kidnapping), 18-4503 (second degree kidnaping), section 18-6101 (rape),
18 section 18-6108 (male rape) or section 18-6501 (robbery), Idaho Code, or any
19 attempt or conspiracy to commit any such crime, upon or against any person
20 who is sixty-five (65) years of age or older at the time of such violation,
21 shall be sentenced to an extended term of imprisonment that shall be computed
22 by increasing the maximum sentence authorized for the crime for which the
23 person is found guilty of or pleaded guilty to by ten (10) years.

24 (2) Any person who is found guilty of or pleads guilty to two (2) or more
25 substantive crimes provided in subsection (1) of this section, which arose
26 out of the same indivisible course of conduct, may only be subject to one (1)
27 enhanced penalty.
