

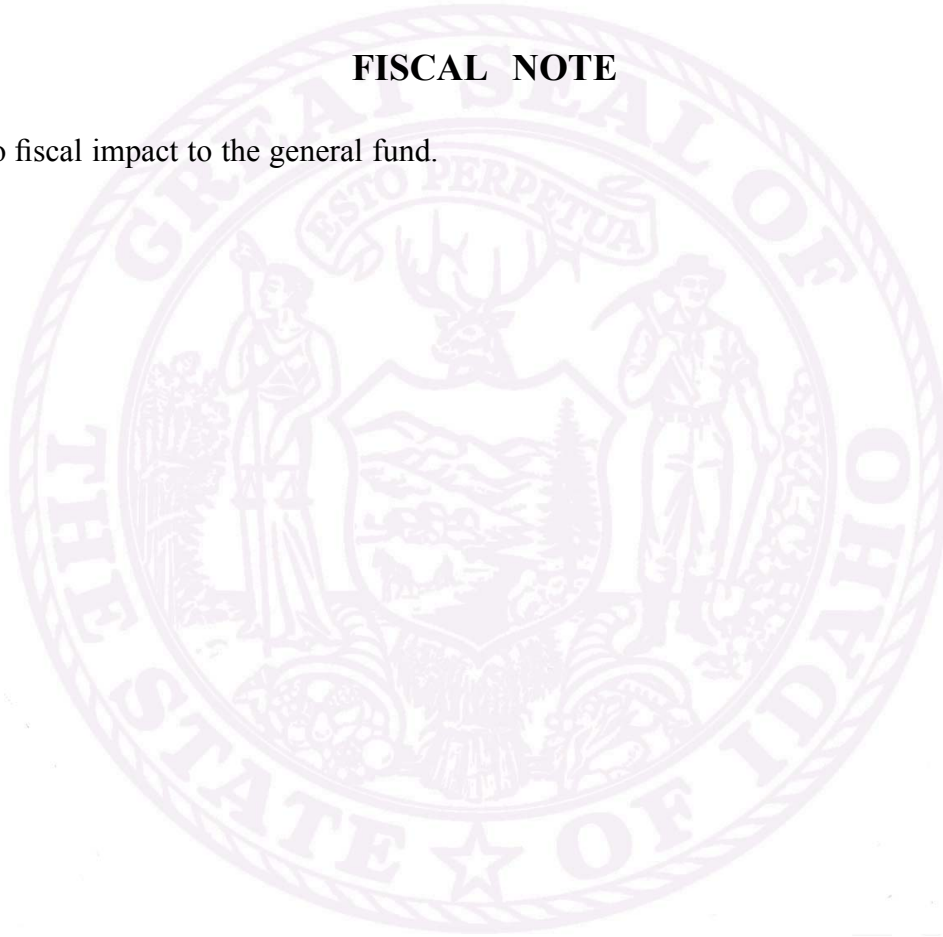
STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS21971

This bill would amend Idaho Code Section 49-307 to provide that the use of a cell phone or other wireless device for the purpose of calling, texting or communicating during the operation of a motor vehicle would be prohibited by teen drivers during the six-month supervised instruction permit process following successful completion of driver training. The provision, which is intended to limit dangerous driver distractions for Idaho's youngest drivers, would be included with others spelled out in this code section, otherwise referred to as the supervised instruction permit process. To become eligible to apply for a class D driver's license, applicants must satisfy the requirements of the class D supervised instruction permit defined in this code section.
