

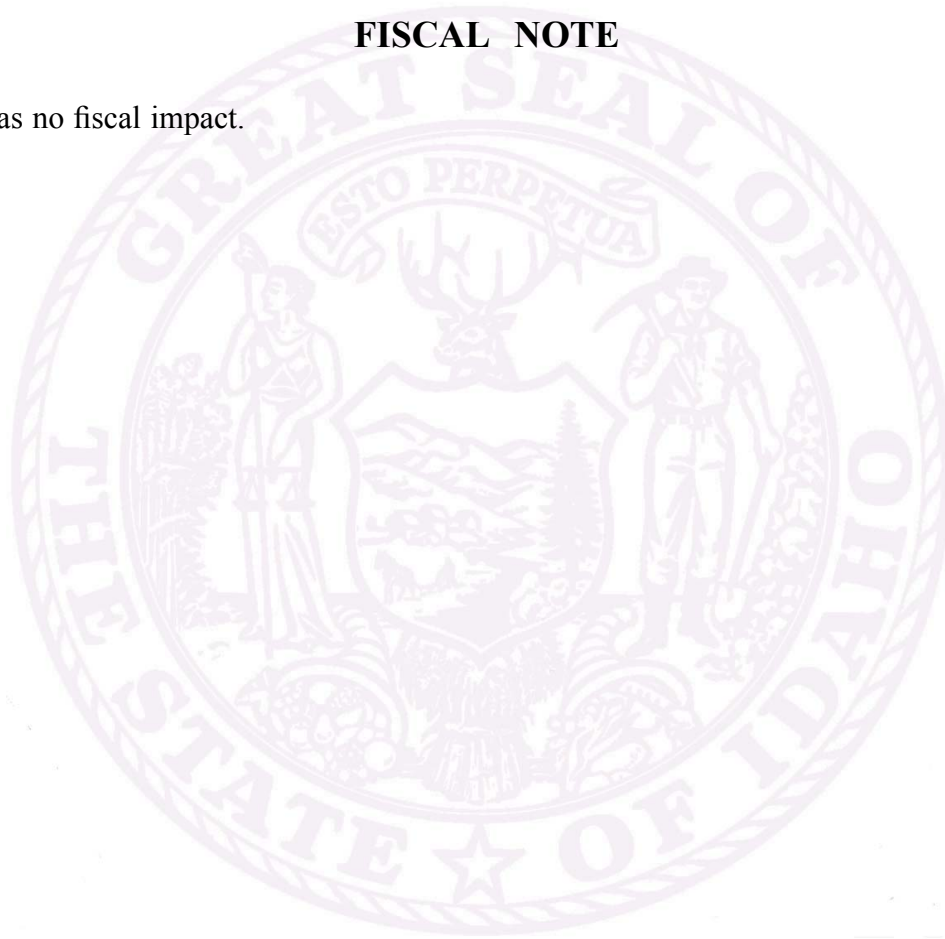
STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS21612

The current language in Idaho Code, Section 9-340B does not identify security systems as a "system" that a public agency can protect from disclosure under the Public Records Act where public safety would be jeopardized by disclosure. The proposed revisions clarify that records of the security systems in place to protect public buildings and their occupants are not records subject to disclosure through a public records request. The records that may be withheld from disclosure include the plans, blueprints and other descriptions of the security system, and the recordings produced by the system.
