

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE



An operator of a commercial motor vehicle who operates such vehicle in a solely intrastate capacity, where the operator does not meet or exceed hours of service restrictions provided pursuant to the federal motor carrier safety administration, shall not be required to obtain and hold a medical examiners's certificate.

The operator of a motor carrier, operating solely in an intrastate capacity, who does not meet or exceed hours of service provisions established by the federal motor carrier safety administration, shall not be required to maintain a log book or meet other recording requirements established by the federal motor carrier safety administration relating to hours of service.
