HOUSE BILL NO. 281

AN ACT

1 RELATING TO THE ELECTION OF CITY COUNCILMEN; AMENDING SECTION 50-707A, IDAHO  
2 CODE, TO REQUIRE CERTAIN CITIES TO ESTABLISH DISTRICTS AND PROVIDE FOR  
3 THE ELECTION OF COUNCILMEN BY DISTRICTS, TO PROVIDE TIME REQUIREMENTS,  
4 TO REVISE PRECINCT PROVISIONS, TO REVISE VERBIAGE, TO PROVIDE FOR SPLIT  
5 PRECINCTS, TO PROVIDE FOR THE REAPPORTIONMENT OF DISTRICTS, TO REVISE  
6 PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DISTRICTS, TO PROVIDE FOR  
7 THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DISTRICTS BY CITIES OF MORE THAN FIFTY THOUSAND  
8 INHABITANTS, TO REVISE PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE DETERMINATION OF THE  
9 PROCESS OF ELECTION, TO REVISE PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE METHOD OF THE  
10 IMPLEMENTATION OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES CONSISTENT WITH SPECIFIED LAW,  
11 TO PROVIDE THAT CERTAIN CITIES SHALL ELECT COUNCILMEN BY DISTRICT AND  
12 DETERMINE THE METHOD OF IMPLEMENTATION OF ELECTION BY DISTRICTS CON-  
13 SISTENT WITH SPECIFIED LAW, TO PROVIDE FOR STAGGERED TERMS, SHORTER  
14 INITIAL TERMS OR AT-LARGE REPRESENTATION AND DISTRICT VACANCIES AND TO  
15 MAKE A TECHNICAL CORRECTION.

17 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

18 SECTION 1. That Section 50-707A, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby  
19 amended to read as follows:

20 50-707A. ELECTION OF COUNCILMEN BY DISTRICTS. (1) Any city may, by or-  
21 dinance, provide for districts and the election of councilmen by districts.  
22 Upon the adoption of such an ordinance and at least one hundred twenty (120)  
23 days prior to each general election, the governing body of the city shall es-  
24 tablish the territory of council districts in accordance with this section.  
25 Any city having more than fifty thousand (50,000) inhabitants based upon the  
26 federal decennial census shall establish districts and shall elect council-  
27 men by districts. Districts shall be established no later than one hundred  
28 twenty (120) days prior to the general election following the date that elec-  
29 tion precincts are established pursuant to the provisions of section 34-301,  
30 Idaho Code, following the first decennial census counting more than fifty  
31 thousand (50,000) inhabitants in the city, or no later than the last day of  
32 2013 for those cities of fifty thousand (50,000) or more inhabitants counted  
33 in the 2010 federal census.

34 (2) Each district shall consist of one (1) or more contiguous election  
35 precincts as established pursuant to the provisions of chapter 3, title 34,  
36 Idaho Code, and each district shall, to the nearest extent possible, con-  
37 tain the same number of people based upon the most recent federal decennial  
38 census. In order to establish districts containing the same number of peo-  
39 ple to the nearest extent possible, precincts may be split once, provided  
40 that no district shall contain more than two (2) partial precincts. The city  
41 council shall reapportion districts after hearing, and by ordinance no later  
42 than one hundred twenty (120) days prior to the general election following

1 the date that election precincts are established pursuant to the provisions  
2 of section 34-301, Idaho Code.

3 (3) Each city ~~providing~~ establishing districts for the election of  
4 councilmen by districts shall establish the number of districts corre-  
5 sponding to the number of council seats determined by the city pursuant to  
6 section 50-701, Idaho Code, or for any city having a governing body governed  
7 by the provisions of ~~sections 50-801 through 50-812~~ chapter 8, title 50,  
8 Idaho Code, the number of council seats determined by the city pursuant to  
9 section 50-805, Idaho Code, provided that a city of more than fifty thousand  
10 (50,000) inhabitants required to elect councilmen by district and having a  
11 governing body pursuant to the provisions of chapter 8, title 50, Idaho Code,  
12 shall establish the number of districts and elect a mayor as if it had passed  
13 an ordinance adopting the process pursuant to the provisions of section  
14 50-809(2), Idaho Code.

15 (4) Upon adoption of ~~such~~ an ordinance establishing city election  
16 districts, a the council shall determine, not less than ninety (90) days  
17 before the next general city election, if council members are to be elected  
18 by electors from the entire city, or by the electors of the said geographic  
19 district. The council shall also determine, not less than ninety (90) days  
20 before the next general election, the method of the implementation of this  
21 its ordinance consistent with the provisions of chapter 14, title 34, Idaho  
22 Code. Cities of more than fifty thousand (50,000) inhabitants shall elect  
23 councilmen by the electors of their respective geographic district and may  
24 otherwise determine the method of implementation of election by districts  
25 consistent with the provisions of chapter 14, title 34, Idaho Code. Imple-  
26 mentation may include staggered terms, shorter initial terms, or at-large  
27 representation and district vacancies as necessary to allow previously  
28 elected councilmen to complete the term to which they were elected.
