AN ACT

1 RELATING TO THE CORRECTIONAL INDUSTRIES ACT; AMENDING SECTION 20-413, IDAHO
2 CODE, TO ESTABLISH ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE BOARD OF COR-
3 RECTION'S CONTRACTING AUTHORITY AND TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS.

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 SECTION 1. That Section 20-413, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
7 amended to read as follows:

8 20-413. GOODS AND SERVICES FOR GOVERNMENT, NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS,
9 AND PUBLIC USE -- CONTRACTS. The board is hereby authorized and empowered to
10 cause the inmates in the state prison to be employed in the rendering of such
11 services and in the production and manufacture of such articles, materials,
12 and supplies as are now or may hereafter be needed by any public institution
13 or agency of the state or any political subdivision thereof, including, but
14 not limited to, counties, districts, municipalities, schools, nonprofit or-
15 ganizations, and other public use. The board may cause the inmates to be em-
16 ployed in rendering such services or producing and manufacturing such arti-
17 cles, materials, and supplies as are now or may hereafter be needed for use
18 by the federal government for any department, agency or corporation thereof.
19 The board may contract to sell products manufactured by correctional indus-
20 tries to retail or wholesale establishments within the state; provided that,
21 the board may contract to sell printing products produced or manufactured by
22 correctional industries only to public institutions or agencies of the state
23 or any political subdivision thereof and may not contract to sell such print-
24 ing products to private retail or private wholesale establishments or enti-
25 ties. The board or its designated agent may enter into contracts for the pur-
26 poses of this article.

27 The board may contract with other state and federal penal institu-
28 tions and with out-of-state governmental entities for the production,
29 manufacture, exchange, sale, or purchase of goods, wares and merchandise
30 manufactured or produced wholly or in part by inmates of the Idaho state pen-
31 itentiary or of any state or federal penal institution.
