HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 28

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND AUTHORIZING THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
2 TO APPOINT AN INTERIM COMMITTEE TO UNDERTAKE AND COMPLETE A STUDY OF THE
3 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE LAWS OF THE STATE OF IDAHO.

5 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 WHEREAS, the statutes governing the sale and consumption of alcoholic
7 beverages in the State of Idaho have developed through a process of additions
8 and deletions, often resulting in a confusing and sometimes contradictory
9 system of governance; and

10 WHEREAS, over the past few legislative sessions several pieces of leg-
11 islation have been considered that proposed amendments to the alcoholic bev-
12 erage statutes, and debate on these bills has illustrated the complexity of
13 present statutes; and

14 WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon the Legislature to achieve a comprehen-
15 sive, consistent and understandable statutory approach that accomplishes
16 appropriate state goals.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the First Regular Ses-
18 sion of the Sixty-second Idaho Legislature, the House of Representatives and
19 the Senate concurring therein, that the Legislative Council is hereby autho-
20 rized to appoint a committee to undertake and complete a study of the alco-
21 holic beverage statutes and all matters relating thereto. The Legislative
22 Council shall determine the number of legislators and membership from each
23 house appointed to the committee and shall authorize the committee to re-
24 ceive input, advice and assistance from interested and affected parties who
25 are not members of the Legislature.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the cochairmen of the committee are autho-
27 rized to appoint advisors with technical expertise in the implementation and
28 administration of alcoholic beverage laws in this state. Any advisors to
29 the committee who are not legislative members shall not be reimbursed from
30 legislative funds for per diem, mileage or other expenses and shall not have
31 voting privileges regarding the committee's recommendations and proposed
32 legislation.

33 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee shall report findings and rec-
34 ommended legislation, if any, to the Second Regular Session of the Sixty-
35 second Idaho Legislature.
