SENATE BILL NO. 1001

AN ACT

1 RELATING TO FISH AND GAME; AMENDING SECTION 36-107, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE  
2 PROVISIONS RELATING TO DISEASE RESEARCH, TO REMOVE OBSOLETE LANGUAGE  
3 AND TO MAKE A TECHNICAL CORRECTION.  
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5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 SECTION 1. That Section 36-107, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby  
7 amended to read as follows:

8 36-107. FISH AND GAME ACCOUNT. (a) The director shall promptly trans-  
9 mit to the state treasurer all moneys received by him, from the sale of hunt-  
10 ing, fishing and trapping licenses, tags and permits or from any other source  
11 connected with the administration of the provisions of the Idaho fish and  
12 game code or any law or regulation for the protection of wildlife, includ-  
13 ing moneys received from the sale of predatory animal furs taken under the  
14 provisions of this chapter, and the state treasurer shall deposit all such  
15 moneys in the fish and game account, which is hereby established, reserved,  
16 set aside, appropriated in the state treasury, and made available until ex-  
17 pended as may be directed by the commission in carrying out the purposes of  
18 the Idaho fish and game code or any law or regulation promulgated for the  
19 protection of wildlife, and shall be used for no other purpose. Pending ex-  
20 penditure or use, surplus moneys in the fish and game account shall be in-  
21 vested by the state treasurer in the manner provided for idle state moneys in  
22 the state treasury by section 67-1210, Idaho Code. Interest received on all  
23 such investments shall be paid into the account. The state controller shall  
24 annually, by August 1 of each year, transfer the sum of one hundred thou-  
25 sand dollars (\$100,000) from the fish and game account to the University of  
26 Idaho Caine Veterinary Teaching and Research Center for disease research re-  
27 garding the interaction of disease between wildlife and domestic livestock.  
28 Said moneys shall be expended on projects agreed upon by the University of  
29 Idaho Caine Veterinary Teaching and Research Center and the ~~state wildlife~~  
30 ~~veterinarian~~ director of the department of fish and game.

31 (b) The commission shall govern the financial policies of the depart-  
32 ment and shall, as provided by law, fix the budget for the operation and main-  
33 tenance of its work for each fiscal year. Said budget shall not be exceeded  
34 by the director.

35 (c) The sum of two dollars (\$2.00) from each license authorized in sec-  
36 tions 36-406(a) and 36-407(b), Idaho Code, which entitles a person to fish,  
37 shall be used for the construction, repair, or rehabilitation of state fish  
38 hatcheries, fishing lakes, or reservoirs.

39 (d) The department is authorized to expend up to one dollar and fifty  
40 cents (\$1.50) from each resident deer and elk tag sold and five dollars  
41 (\$5.00) from each nonresident deer and elk tag sold to fund the department's  
42 big game landowner-sportsman's relations program.
