SENATE AMENDMENT TO S.B. NO. 1006

AMENDMENT TO THE BILL

2 On page 4 of the printed bill, following line 19, insert:

3 "SECTION 2. That Section 40-203B, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
4 amended to read as follows:

5 40-203B. ABANDONMENT OR ASSUMING CONTROL OF A HIGHWAY. Whenever the
6 Idaho transportation department is either planning to abandon any section
7 or all of a state highway to a county, a city or a highway district or as-
8 sume control of a section or all of a highway which is under the jurisdic-
9 tion of a county, city or a highway district, the transportation department
10 shall first obtain the consent of the applicable local highway jurisdiction
11 before it may abandon or assume control of the highway. Consent shall be ob-
12 tained by passage of a resolution by the local highway jurisdiction assent-
13 ing to the proposed action of the transportation department. Prior to con-
14 senting to an abandonment or assumption of the applicable highway, the local
15 highway jurisdiction may conduct a public hearing and also provide notice to
16 any impacted property owners, businesses, industries and enterprises. If
17 consent is not obtained as provided in this section, the action by the trans-
18 portation department regarding the abandonment of a state highway or assump-
19 tion of control of a local jurisdiction highway shall be null, void, and of no
20 force and effect."

21 CORRECTION TO TITLE

22 On page 1, in line 3, delete "AND" and insert: ", "; and in line 6, follow-
23 ing "HIGHWAYS" insert: "; AND AMENDING SECTION 40-203B, IDAHO CODE, TO PRO-
24 VIDE THAT PRIOR TO CONSENTING TO AN ABANDONMENT OR ASSUMING CONTROL OF AN AP-
25 PPLICABLE HIGHWAY, THE LOCAL HIGHWAY JURISDICTION MAY CONDUCT A PUBLIC HEAR-
26 ING AND PROVIDE NOTICE".
