- 8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:
- 9 SECTION 1. That Chapter 16, Title 59, Idaho Code, be, and the same is 10 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and des-11 ignated as Section 59-1602A, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:
 - 59-1602A. NONCOMPETITIVE APPOINTMENT OF CERTAIN DISABLED VETER-ANS. (1) Whenever a vacancy occurs in a position as a nonclassified officer or employee, the appointing authority may appoint a disabled veteran on a noncompetitive basis if all of the following occur:
 - (a) The disabled veteran has served in the United States armed forces and is included on a United States armed forces permanent disability list with a disability rating of at least thirty percent (30%) or the disabled veteran has been rated by the United States department of veterans affairs as having a compensable service-connected disability of at least thirty percent (30%);
 - (b) The disabled veteran presents to the appointing authority written documentation from an appropriate department of the federal government certifying the existence and extent of the disability. The certification must have been issued by the appropriate department of the federal government within the year preceding appointment; and
 - (c) The appointing authority determines that the disabled veteran meets the minimum qualifications for the vacant position.
 - (2) If an appointing authority elects to appoint a disabled veteran to a vacant position on a noncompetitive basis pursuant to the provisions of subsection (1) of this section, an appointing authority is not required to interview any other person.
 - SECTION 2. That Chapter 53, Title 67, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a $\underline{\text{NEW SECTION}}$, to be known and designated as Section 67-5306A, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:
- 67-5306A. NONCOMPETITIVE APPOINTMENT OF CERTAIN DISABLED VETER37 ANS. (1) Whenever a vacancy occurs in a position in the classified service,
 38 the appointing authority may appoint a disabled veteran on a noncompetitive
 39 basis if all of the following occur:

- (a) The disabled veteran has served in the United States armed forces and is included on a United States armed forces permanent disability list with a disability rating of at least thirty percent (30%) or the disabled veteran has been rated by the United States department of veterans affairs as having a compensable service-connected disability of at least thirty percent (30%);
- (b) The disabled veteran presents to the appointing authority written documentation from an appropriate department of the federal government certifying the existence and extent of the disability. The certification must have been issued by the appropriate department of the federal government within the year preceding appointment; and
- (c) The appointing authority determines that the disabled veteran meets the minimum qualifications for the vacant position.
