

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

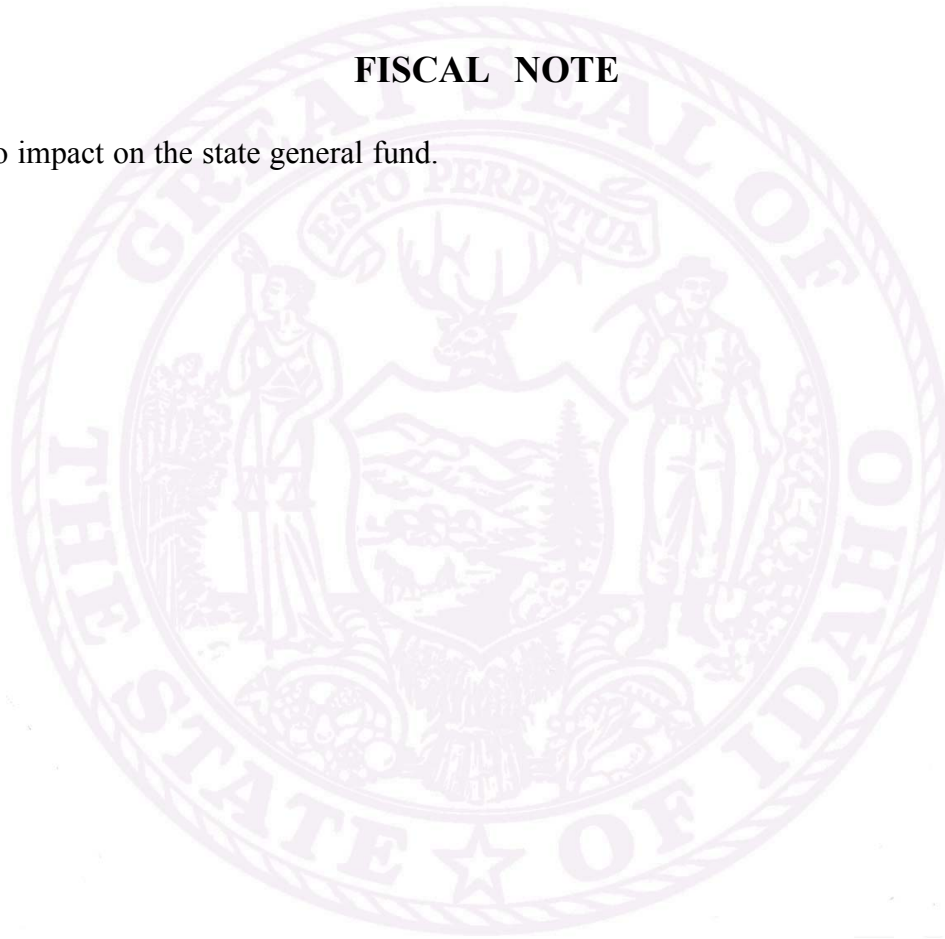
RS21845

This legislation adds a new section to Idaho Code that establishes restrictions in gathering evidence or other information through the use of a drone or other unmanned aircraft. Except for law enforcement agencies under exigent circumstances, the new sections require consent from property owners before unmanned aircraft can conduct surveillance.

Aggrieved parties in civil actions may obtain all appropriate relief to prevent or remedy a violation. No information obtained in violation of this act may be admissible as evidence in a criminal proceeding.
