SENATE BILL NO. 1068, As Amended

AN ACT

1 RELATING TO MEMBERS OF THE ARMED SERVICES AND THEIR SPOUSES; AMENDING SEC-
2 TION 67-2620, IDAHO CODE, TO ALLOW FOR LICENSURE, CERTIFICATION OR REG-
3 ISTRATION FOR SERVICE MEMBERS AND SPOUSES.

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 SECTION 1. That Section 67-2620, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
7 amended to read as follows:

8 67-2620. MILITARY EDUCATION TRAINING AND SERVICE -- QUALIFICATIONS
9 FOR LICENSURE, CERTIFICATION OR REGISTRATION. (1) Each of the professional
10 and occupational licensing boards within the department of self-governing
11 agencies may accept military education, training or service by an individual
12 as a member of the armed forces or reserves of the United States, the national
13 guard of any state, the military reserves of any state or the naval militia of
14 any state toward the qualifications to receive licensure, certification or
15 registration. Each professional and occupational licensing board is autho-
16 rized to promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this subsection.

17 (2) Each of the professional and occupational licensing boards within
18 the department of self-governing agencies may expedite the application of
19 a member of the armed forces or reserves of the United States, the national
20 guard of any state, the military reserves of any state or the naval militia
21 of any state or a spouse of such person to receive licensure, certification
22 or registration if such member or spouse of such member possesses necessary
23 education, qualifications or licensure or certification from another state,
24 possession, commonwealth or territory. Each professional and occupational
25 licensing board is authorized to promulgate rules to implement the provi-
26 sions of this subsection.
