Chairman Loertscher called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

RS 21888: Rep. Morse presented RS 21888, legislation amending the Regulatory Takings Act

to extend and protect property rights.

In response to committee questions, Mr. Morse stated they chose 50% as it is normal and they have to establish compensation somehow. He stated they chose 50% as a statutory benchmark. He also stated they were trying to stay away from

causing huge burdens on government.

Chairman Loertscher turned the gavel over to Vice Chairman Batt.

Rep. Barbieri made a motion to introduce RS 21888 with the following changes: MOTION:

on Page 2, line 46, after "return receipt requested", add ", or process service with return affidavit"; on Page 3, line 36, take out "No"; on Page 3, line 37-38, take out "shall give rise to a claim under this chapter." Motion carried by voice vote.

Vice Chairman Batt turned the gavel over to **Chairman Loertscher**.

RS 21836C1: Tim Hurst, Director, Secretary of State, presented RS 21836C1, legislation

providing additional ways for people to go early to vote and will be used instead of in-person absentee voting. He stated the legislation does not expand voting, but

it does speed up the process.

MOTION: Rep. Smith made a motion to introduce RS 21836C1. Motion carried by voice

vote.

RS 21897: Tim Hurst, Director, Secretary of State, presented RS 21897, legislation cleaning

> up the Idaho Code regarding election procedures which standardizes the filing forms and procedures for all taxing districts, and specifies the date by which

wording for a ballot must be given.

In response to committee questions Mr. Hurst stated the signature requirement is

not needed because a voter is already affirming who they are when they vote.

Rep. Crane made a motion to introduce RS 21897 with the following changes: MOTION:

Page 10, line 23, take out "thirty (30) days" and replace with "sixty-five (65) days".

Rep. Anderson(1) made a substitute motion to introduce RS 21897.

Monks presented RS 21842, legislation that requires the parent or guardian to be notified before an autopsy is done. **MOTION:** Rep. Luker made a motion to introduce RS 21842.
