RS 21992: **Jeff Youtz, Capital Commission**, presented **RS 21992**, proposed legislation regarding a separate fund for the maintenance and repairs of the Capitol building.

In response to committee questions, **Mr. Youtz**, stated the fund will be split into three-the permanent fund, reserve fund, and the income fund. He stated there has always been an endowment fund since the public schools were established.

RS 21904: **Rep. Perry** presented **RS 21904**, proposed legislation that allows historical horse racing.

RS 21877C2: **Rep. Gestirn** presented **RS 21877C2**, proposed legislation which cleans up the language in Title 18 Section 50-308 of the Idaho Code so it does not contradict current law.

MOTION: **Rep. Packer** made a motion to introduce **RS 21877C2**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**
