**Chairman Loertscher** called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

**RS 22048:** **Rep. Gannon** presented **RS 22048**, a concurrent resolution rejecting the State Lottery Commission Administrative Rules **Docket No. 52-0103-1203**. He stated the Rules entail specifications and operations for terminal produced games which deliver play on multipurpose vending machines to be placed in social environment areas and other nontraditional places.

**MOTION:** **Rep. Batt** made a motion to introduce **RS 22048**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

**RS 22018C1:** **Rob Shoplock**, Professional Firefighters of Idaho, presented **RS 22018C1**, proposed legislation to change current workers compensation law to include occupational diseases for firefighters.

**MOTION:** **Rep. Woodings** made a motion to introduce **RS 22018C1**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

**RS 22049:** **Rep. Gibbs** presented **RS 22049**, proposed legislation to allow resort communities to issue liquor by the drink licenses. He stated the purpose was to create legislation for resort communities, like Driggs, allowing them to issue nontransferable licenses.

In response to committee questions, **Rep. Gibbs** stated city ordinances can be changed with the changing of staff so legislation seemed to be the best way to go forward. He also stated other alcohol licenses would not be affected and the Idaho Liquor and Beverage Association can explain further during the bill hearing.

**MOTION:** **Rep. Anderson** made a motion to introduce **RS 22049**. **Motion carried by voice vote.** **Reps. Andrus, Crane and Palmer** requested to be recorded as voting **NAY**.

**H 90:** **Bob Clements**, retired ISP Lieutenant of Bureau Manager Alcohol Beverage Control, presented **H 90**, a bill amending section 23-903 of the Idaho Code which relates to the transfers of licenses issued for retail sale of liquor by the drink.

**Russell Westerberg**, on behalf of the Idaho Liquor and Beverage Association, stated they prepared an amendment to the bill to clarify nontransferable licenses. He stated the Association supports the bill.

**Pam Eaton**, Idaho Lodging and Restaurant Association support the bill because of the transferability of the licenses between similar businesses.

**Rep. Luker** gave a short history on the laws regarding licenses to retail liquor in Idaho. He also stated he supported the amendment because it clears up any confusion.

**MOTION:** **Rep. Luker** made a motion to send **H 90** to General Orders with amendments attached. **Motion carried by voice vote.** **Rep. Sims** will sponsor the bill on the floor.

**ADJOURN:** There being no further business to come before the Committee, the meeting was adjourned at 9:43 a.m.
