Chairman Loertscher called the meeting to order at 8:24 a.m.

- **MOTION: Rep. Woodings** made a motion to approve the minutes of the February 25, 26, and 27, 2013 meetings. **Motion carried by voice vote.**
- **RS 22220: Rep. Shepherd** presented **RS 22220**, proposed legislation that amends existing law relating to irrigation and drainage to provide additional requirements relating to well construction standards.
- MOTION: Rep. Anderson(1) made a motion to introduce RS 22220 and refer it to the Resources and Conservation Committee. Motion carried by voice vote.
- **RS 22223: Rep. Boyle** presented **RS 22223**, proposed legislation which amends existing law relating to fish and game to provide that certain monies shall be earmarked for sportsmen access programs; and to revise provisions relating to the transfer and use of certain monies from the Expendable Big Game Depredation Fund.
- MOTION: Rep. Anderson(1) made a motion to introduce RS 22223 and refer it to the Agricultural Affairs Committee. Motion carried by voice vote.
- **RS 22210: Rep. Gestrin** presented **RS 22210**, proposed legislation that amends existing law relating to registrations to revise registration provisions relating to certain vehicles; to provide that certain certificates of title or evidence of prior registration shall be sufficient evidence of ownership for certificate of number and registration purposes and to authorize the Department of Parks and Recreation to share registration information with the Idaho Transportation Department.
- MOTION: Rep. Palmer made a motion to introduce RS 22210 and refer it to the Transportation and Defense Committee. Motion carried by voice vote.
- **RS 22233: Rep. Monks** presented **RS 22233**, proposed legislation that amends and adds to existing law relating to firearms, explosives and other deadly weapons to revise and establish additional provisions relating to the prohibition of federal regulation of certain firearms if those items are prohibited after March 1, 2013.

In response to committee questions, **Rep. Monks** stated the main purpose is to avoid firearms and accessories from being banned by the Federal Government.

MOTION: Rep. Luker made a motion to introduce RS 22233 and send it directly to the Second Reading Calendar. Motion carried by voice vote. Reps. Gannon, Smith and Woodings requested to be recorded as voting NAY. Rep. Monks will sponsor the bill on the floor.

- **RS 22019C2: Rep. Luker** presented **RS 22019C2**, proposed legislation that amends existing law relating to the election of city councilmen to require certain cities to establish districts and to provide for the election of councilmen by districts.
- MOTION: Rep. Crane made a motion to introduce RS 22019C2. Motion carried by voice vote.
