- Chairman Loertscher** called the meeting to order at 9:01 a.m.
- MOTION:** **Rep. Woodings** made a motion to approve the minutes of the March 6, 7, 8, and 11, 2013 meetings. **Motion carried by voice vote.**
- SCR 125:** **Dennis Stevenson**, Office of Administrative Rules, Rules Coordinator, presented **SCR 125**, a concurrent resolution that approves administrative rules that impose a fee or charge, with stated exceptions, and rejecting certain agency rules that are not approved for the 2013 Legislative session.
- MOTION:** **Rep. Batt** made a motion to send **SCR 125** to the floor with a **DO PASS** recommendation. **Motion carried by voice vote.** **Rep. Smith** will sponsor the bill on the floor.
- SCR 126:** **Dennis Stevenson**, Office of Administrative Rules, Rules Coordinator, presented **SCR 126**, a concurrent resolution that approves and extends temporary rules reviewed by the Legislature for the 2013 Legislative session.
- MOTION:** **Rep. Monks** made a motion to send **SCR 126** to the floor with a **DO PASS** recommendation. **Motion carried by voice vote.** **Rep. Monks** will sponsor the bill on the floor.
- SCR 124:** **Rep. Holtzclaw** presented **SCR 124**, a concurrent resolution that honors five Idaho servicemen who fought and lost their lives in Afghanistan within the past year.
- MOTION:** **Rep. Packer** made a motion to send **SCR 124** to the floor with a **DO PASS** recommendation. **Motion carried by voice vote.** **Rep. Holtzclaw** will sponsor the bill on the floor.
- S 1138aa:** **Rep. Gibbs** presented **S 1138aa**, a bill that amends existing law relating to the Local Planning Act that provides overlay zoning districts have specific standards; that in no event shall the governing board by local ordinance enact provisions that abrogate the statutory authority of a public health district, state and/or federal agency; that enumerate express standards regarding the Local Planning Act, and that provide procedures for reconsideration and to provide standards for appeal. He stated the bill amends Section 67-6522, of the Idaho Code.
- Nancy Stricklin**, Association of Idaho Counties, stated she is **in support** of **S 1138aa**. She stated three areas of the Local Planning Act are changed in the bill. She said the changes are necessary and her association is in full support.

In response to committee questions, **Ms. Stricklin** stated the 14-day timeline for submitting a reconsideration is a standard procedure. She said they do not want to have too much time pass by before the appeals process. She stated the decisions must include information about compliance and any out of compliance issues as well. She stated that all parties involved in the matter will receive a copy of the decision.

**Lorna Jorgensen**, Ada County Commissioners, stated she is **in support** of **S 1138aa**. She said the parameters are laid out clearly for all counties.

**MOTION:** **Rep. Palmer** made a motion to send **S 1138aa** to the floor with a **DO PASS** recommendation. **Motion carried by voice vote.** **Rep. Gibbs** will sponsor the bill on the floor.

**ADJOURN:** There being no further business to come before the Committee, the meeting was adjourned at 9:39 a.m.
