

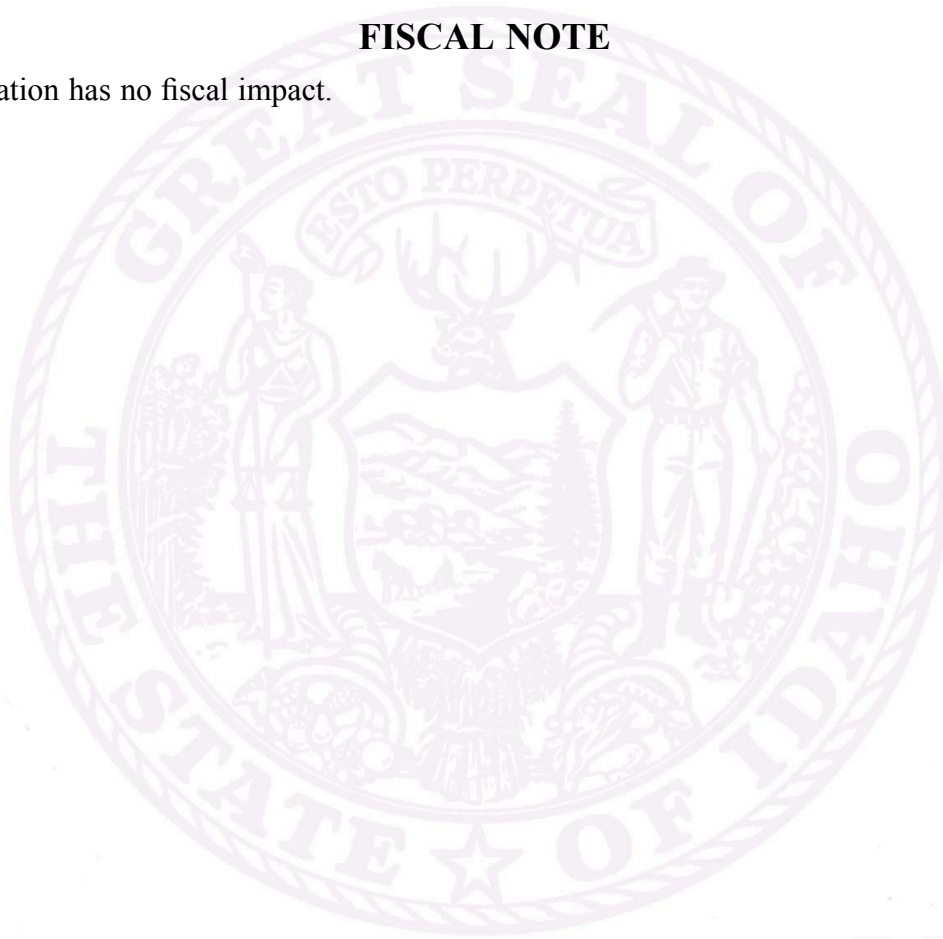
STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS22515

This legislation clarifies that an election for the office of irrigation district director is not required when the district's secretary verifies that there is either: (1) only one qualified candidate for the office of director, in which case the qualified candidate is declared elected; or (2) no qualified candidate for the office, in which case the incumbent director's term continues until a successor is elected and qualified, as provided by law. This legislation also removes the outdated requirement of immediate delivery of a certificate of election. Pursuant to Idaho Code Section 43-202, a certificate of election is presented to an irrigation district director on the date the director's term of office begins.
