

## STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

### RS23086

In addition to the appropriation for the Idaho Commission for Libraries in FY 2014, this bill adds \$40,000 from the federal grant fund to pay for a Talking Book Service Volunteer Coordinator.

This bill is also the FY 2015 appropriation to the Idaho Commission for Libraries for \$3,510,700 from the General Fund, \$74,400 in dedicated funds, and \$1,571,200 in federal funds with full-time equivalent positions capped at 39.50. It includes \$53,000 in benefit cost increases, \$36,100 in contract inflation, \$26,000 for a replacement vehicle, a reduction of \$12,100 for statewide cost allocation, \$38,600 for an increase in employee compensation, and \$600 for an increase in IT-related billing fees. It also includes \$110,000 from the General Fund to pay for the ongoing Learning Express Library software license costs, as well as \$100,000 in one-time General Fund moneys to fund Read To Me Mini-Grants for school libraries. The total appropriation of the Commission for Libraries for FY 2015 is \$5,156,300.
