HOUSE BILL NO. 637

AN ACT

1 RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT PRO-
2 GRAM/DIVISION OF ADMINISTRATORS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015; PROVIDING FOR EX-
3 PENDITURES TO THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT PROGRAM/DIVISION
4 OF ADMINISTRATORS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015; APPROPRIATING GENERAL FUND MON-
5 EYS FOR TRANSFER TO THE PUBLIC SCHOOL INCOME FUND; APPROPRIATING FUNDS
6 TO THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT PROGRAM/DIVISION OF ADMIN-
7 ISTRATORS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015; AND AMENDING SECTION 33-1004E, IDAHO
8 CODE, TO INCREASE THE BASE SALARY FOR ADMINISTRATORS.

10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

11 SECTION 1. The following amount shall be expended for the Public
12 Schools Educational Support Program/Division of Administrators for the pe-
13 riod July 1, 2014, through June 30, 2015:

16 SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated the following amount to be
17 transferred to the Public School Income Fund for the period July 1, 2014,
18 through June 30, 2015:

21 SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Public Schools Educa-
22 tional Support Program/Division of Administrators the following amount to
23 be expended from the listed fund for the period July 1, 2014, through June 30,
24 2015:

27 SECTION 4. That Section 33-1004E, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
28 amended to read as follows:

29 33-1004E. DISTRICT'S SALARY-BASED APPORTIONMENT. Each district shall
30 be entitled to a salary-based apportionment calculated as provided in this
31 section.

32 1. To determine the apportionment for instructional staff, first de-
33 termine the district average experience and education index by placing all
34 eligible district certificated instructional employees on the statewide

1 index provided in section 33-1004A, Idaho Code. The resulting average is
2 the district index. Districts with an index above the state average in-
3 dex shall receive their actual index but not more than the state average
4 plus .03 for the 1994-95 school year, and shall receive their actual index
5 but not more than the state average plus .06 for the 1995-96 school year,
6 and thereafter shall receive their actual district index. The district
7 instructional staff index shall be multiplied by the instructional base
8 salary of \$23,123. The amount so determined shall be multiplied by the
9 district staff allowance for instructional staff determined as provided in
10 section 33-1004(2), Idaho Code. The instructional salary allocation shall
11 be further increased by the amount necessary for each full-time equivalent
12 instructional staff member placed on the experience and education index to
13 be allocated at least the minimum salary mandated by this section. Full-time
14 instructional staff salaries shall be determined from a salary schedule de-
15 veloped by each district and submitted to the state department of education.
16 No full-time instructional staff member shall be paid less than \$31,000.
17 If an instructional staff member has been certified by the national board
18 for professional teaching standards, the staff member shall be designated
19 as a master teacher and receive \$2,000 per year for five (5) years. The
20 instructional salary shall be increased by \$2,000 for each master teacher
21 provided however, that no such awards shall be paid for the period July 1,
22 2010, through June 30, 2011, nor shall any liabilities accrue or payments
23 be made pursuant to this section in the future to any individuals who would
24 have otherwise qualified for a payment during this stated time period. The
25 resulting amount is the district's salary-based apportionment for instruc-
26 tional staff. For purposes of this section, teachers qualifying for the
27 salary increase as master teacher shall be those who have been recognized as
28 national board certified teachers as of July 1 of each year.

29 2. To determine the apportionment for district administrative staff,
30 first determine the district average experience and education index by plac-
31 ing all eligible certificated administrative employees on the statewide
32 index provided in section 33-1004A, Idaho Code. The resulting average is
33 the district index. Districts with an index above the state average index
34 shall receive their actual index but not more than the state average plus .03
35 for the school year 1994-95, and shall receive their actual index but not
36 more than the state average index plus .06 for the 1995-96 school year, and
37 thereafter shall receive their actual district index. The district adminis-
38 trative staff index shall be multiplied by the base salary of ~~\$31,833~~\$32,151.
39 The amount so determined shall be multiplied by the district staff allowance
40 for administrative staff determined as provided in section 33-1004(3),
41 Idaho Code. The resulting amount is the district's salary-based apportion-
42 ment for administrative staff.

43 3. To determine the apportionment for classified staff, multiply
44 \$19,058 by the district classified staff allowance determined as provided in
45 section 33-1004(4), Idaho Code. The amount so determined is the district's
46 apportionment for classified staff.

47 4. The district's salary-based apportionment shall be the sum of the
48 apportionments calculated in subsections 1., 2. and 3., of this section,
49 plus the benefit apportionment as provided in section 33-1004F, Idaho Code.
