

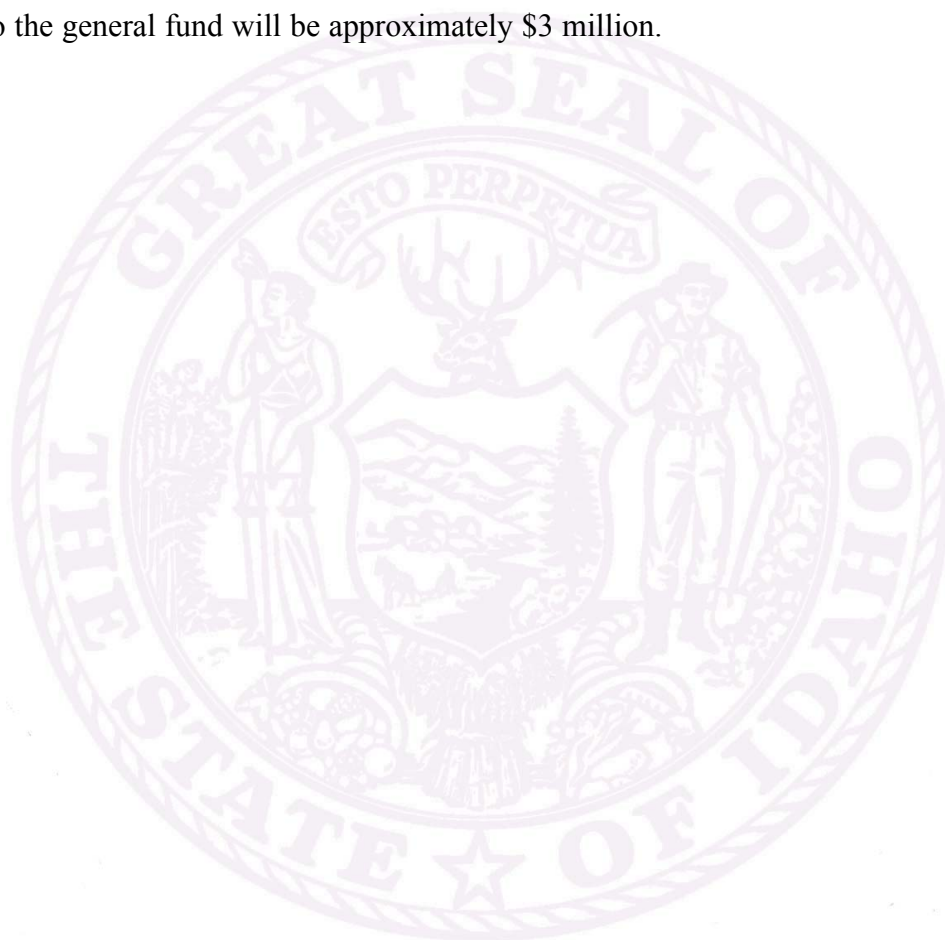
STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS22578

The bill would clarify which students may be eligible for the Mastery Advancement Scholarship, clarify that professional certificates are eligible for advanced opportunity programs, establish a program whereby \$200 will be available for high school juniors and \$400 for high school seniors for dual credit and professional technical certifications, change the credits required for 7th and 9th graders that participate in the "8 in 6" program, and clarify how liquor fund monies are to be used in relation to advanced opportunity programs.

FISCAL NOTE

The cost to the general fund will be approximately \$3 million.
