

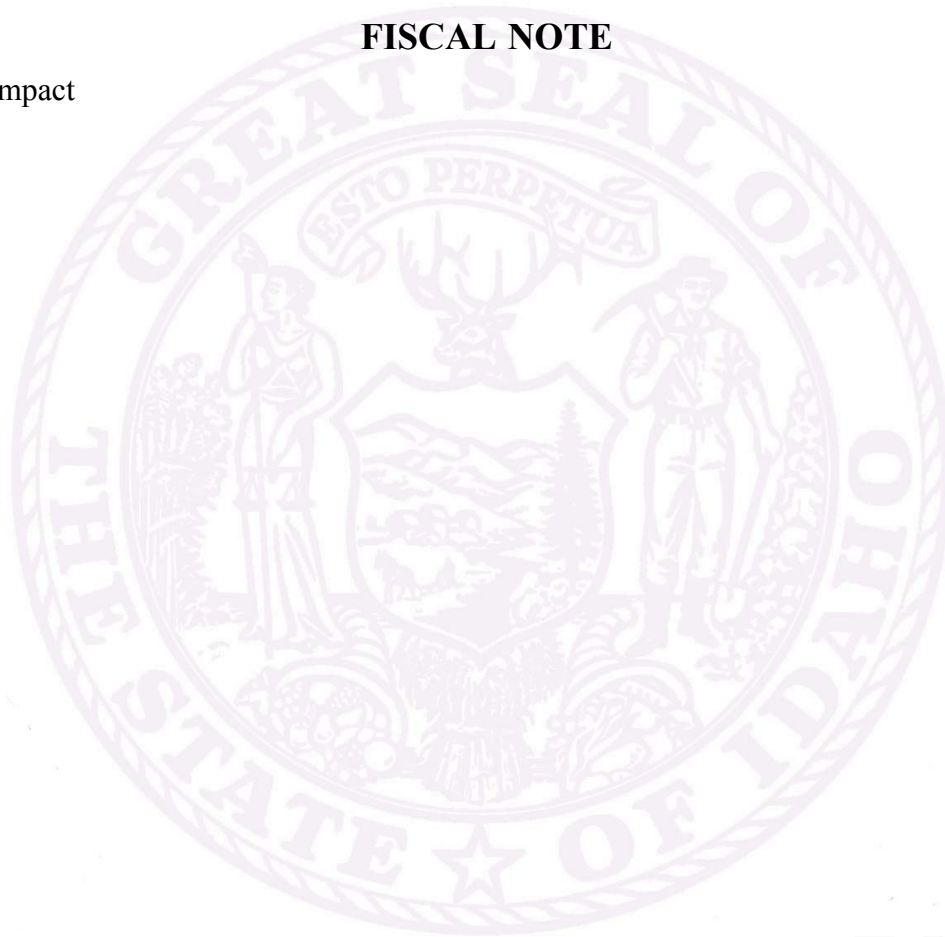
STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS22566

Idaho currently has areas where public roads go through private lands. At times these can be vast, unfenced tracts of land. The intent of this legislation is to allow for the option of posting signs where public roads enter private lands alerting the traveler that trespass off the road is not allowed. This option will save the landowner the expense and labor of planting posts every 660 feet on huge tracts of unfenced land. A sign will also be placed where the public road exits private land so the traveler knows that access off the road right away is no longer posted against trespass. The sign will convey the number of miles and if one or both sides of the road are private land where trespass is not allowed, or a map of sufficient detail to express the same.
