SENATE AMENDMENT TO S.B. NO. 1252

AMENDMENT TO THE BILL

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2 On page 2 of the printed bill, delete lines 42 through 49; and delete page
3 3, and insert:

4 "SECTION 2. That Chapter 3, Title 72, Idaho Code, be, and the same is
5 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a NEW SECTION, to be known and des-
6 ignated as Section 72-301A, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

7 72-301A. ALTERNATIVE MEANS OF SECURING SELF-INSURANCE. The provi-
8 sions of section 72-301, Idaho Code, with respect to security, shall be met
9 alternatively, by the employer demonstrating to the commission that secu-
10 rity for its self-insured worker's compensation program is covered by a cost
11 reimbursement contract with the federal government for work performed in
12 connection with the Idaho national laboratory including research, devel-
13 opment, demonstration, testing, national security, defense, environmental
14 cleanup or waste management if the cost reimbursement contract provides for
15 the payment as otherwise required in this chapter. An employer that becomes
16 self-insured under this section is not required to provide and maintain a se-
17 curity deposit, is not required to have a payroll history and is not required
18 to have excess insurance coverage. In addition, because of the federal
19 government reimbursement, the employer's self-insurance program includes
20 coverage for claims for events taking place before the effective date of the
21 self-insured program, and no separate coverage or deposit for such claims is
22 required.

23 The commission shall promulgate rules governing the administration of
24 employer self-insurance under this section."
