SENATE BILL NO. 1333

AN ACT

1 RELATING TO PUBLIC WORKS; AMENDING SECTION 44-1001, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE  
2 THAT IN WORK INVOLVING THE EXPENDITURE OF FEDERAL AID FUNDS, SPECIFIED  
3 LAW SHALL NOT BE ENFORCED IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO CONFLICT WITH OR BE  
4 CONTRARY TO THE FEDERAL STATUTES PRESCRIBING A LABOR PREFERENCE TO HON-  
5 ORABLY DISCHARGED MEMBERS OF THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES, INCLUDING  
6 AIRMEN.  
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8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

9 SECTION 1. That Section 44-1001, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby  
10 amended to read as follows:

11 44-1001. EMPLOYMENT OF RESIDENTS OF IDAHO -- WAGE SCALE -- FEDERAL  
12 FUNDS. In all state, county, municipal, and school construction, repair,  
13 and maintenance work under any of the laws of this state the contractor, or  
14 person in charge thereof must employ ninety-five percent (95%) bona fide  
15 Idaho residents as employees on any such contracts except for procurement  
16 authorized in section 67-2808(2), Idaho Code, or where under such contracts  
17 fifty (50) or less persons are employed the contractor may employ ten percent  
18 (10%) nonresidents, provided however, in such a case employers must give  
19 preference to the employment of bona fide Idaho residents in the performance  
20 of such work; provided, that in work involving the expenditure of federal aid  
21 funds this act shall not be enforced in such a manner as to conflict with or be  
22 contrary to the federal statutes prescribing a labor preference to honorably  
23 discharged members of the United States armed forces, including airmen, sol-  
24 diers, sailors, and marines, prohibiting as unlawful any other preference or  
25 discrimination among the citizens of the United States.
