2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING A CERTAIN RULE DOCKET OF
3 THE OUTFITTERS AND GUIDES LICENSING BOARD RELATING TO RULES OF THE OUT-
4 FITTERS AND GUIDES LICENSING BOARD.

5 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive
7 agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the
8 event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with leg-
9 islative intent; and

10 WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that a certain rule docket
11 of the Outfitters and Guides Licensing Board relating to Rules of the Out-
12 fitters and Guides Licensing Board is not consistent with legislative intent
13 and should be rejected.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Second Regular Ses-
15 sion of the Sixty-second Idaho Legislature, the Senate and the House of Rep-
16 resentatives concurring therein, that IDAPA 25.01.01, Outfitters and Guides
17 Licensing Board, Rules of the Outfitters and Guides Licensing Board, adopted
18 as a pending rule under Docket Number 25-0101-1201, the entire rulemaking
19 docket, be, and the same is hereby rejected and declared null, void and of no
20 force and effect.
